Khmer Health Board	\$9,570	West Seattle/White Center (CD 8) Rainier Valley (CD 2)	Address intergenerational stigma, tension, and lack of awareness about mental health in the Cambodian American Community and increase utilization of mental health services amongst the Cambodian Americans in King County.
UTOPIA (United Territories of Pacific Islanders Alliance) QTPI Behavioral Health	\$9,999	Seattle and South King County (CD 2, 5, 7, 9)	Provide behavioral health education, resources, and information for LGBTQI Pacific Islanders, and other communities of color. Culturally responsive programming to combat the multiple stigmas impacting immigrant, refugees and communities of color dealing with mental health and/or substance abuse.
Vashon Youth and Family Services	\$9,667	Vashon Island (CD 8)	Support Latinx Islanders behavioral health by increasing their sense of community, inclusion, and connections by providing positive peers support, reducing stigma of behavioral health, and increasing awareness of and connections to local social services.
Vietnamese Health Board	\$9,875	Rainier Valley, and West Seattle/White Center (CD 2,8)	Develop tools, including common language on mental health in both English and Vietnamese, to support learning and understanding of behavioral health. Provide tools and guides to support inter-generational conversations on mental health in the Vietnamese community.
Cowlitz Indian Tribe	\$24,486	Seattle and South King County (CD 1, 2, 5, 7)	SUD Outreach, SUD assessments, make appropriate referrals, outpatient treatment intake, and peer counseling services at Chief Seattle Club, Seattle Burien Municipal Court, and several local hospitals.
IKRON	\$24,999	East King County (CD 1, 3, 6)	Provide behavioral health education, training and resources to culturally diverse groups.
NAMI Eastside-Community Building Grant	\$24,650	East King County (CD 3, 6)	Understand and serve community identified needs. Retool organization offerings to increase inclusion of the diverse cultures in East King County.
King County Sexual Assault Resource Center	\$24,999	South King County (CD 5, 7, 9)	In collaboration with El Centro de la Raza conduct groups that seek to strengthen community, reduce stigma of and increase awareness of behavioral health issues related to sexual assault in the Latinx Community in South King County.

LifeWire	\$16,523	Bellevue (CD 6)	Provide documented and undocumented Latinx survivors of domestic violence access to groups more culturally responsive support groups related to behavioral health and substance abuse.
Refugee Women's Alliance	\$24,999	SeaTac (CD 5)	Build community leadership through a train-the-trainers program about behavioral health and substance abuse within the Somali, Eritrean and Ethiopian communities in South King County.
Southwest Youth and Family Services	\$20,125	Des Moines (CD 8)	Partner with school to deliver 3R's (Rights, Respect and Responsibilities) curricula to students at Pacific Middle School in Des Moines.
WAPI Community Services	\$24,768	South King County (CD 5, 7, 9)	Offer Kings Rise Up (KRU) programing specifically to male students of color through a series of 6 session that will address stigma surrounded young men of color who struggle with mental health, addiction and violence.
Atlantic Street Center	\$49,993	Seattle and South King County (CD 2, 5)	Partner with Somali Community Services of Seattle and the Iraqi Community Center of Washington to deliver the Healthy Brain-Healthy Minds curriculum to increase awareness about behavioral health and substance use amongst low income African Americans, Somali and Iraqi individuals.
