Executive Offfice Changes

Zero Suicide (PRI-06) Program Implementation – proposal not approved

Not the appropriate time to begin a new initiative with MIDD renewal so close

Multipronged Opioid Strategies (CD-07) Investments – proposal not approved

- The Executive's Office understands the community need in this area and intends to continue investing in strategies that help with opioid use disorders.
- There are multiple proposals for new investments in opioid strategies coming from DCHS and from Public Health at this time, as well as new resources from opioid settlement funds and the newly passed Crisis Care Centers property tax levy.
- King County is working on cross-agency and cross-revenue coordination of opioid service plans, and will make additional investments after that important planning work is complete

Executive Office Additions

<u>Jail Health Services – MOUD Expansion (CD-07) - \$535,000</u>

 Increase number of providers who can provide prescription and medication management in King County jails.

<u>Jail Health Services – Coordinated Discharge (RR-06) - \$681,000</u>

Increase psychiatric capacity and SUD assessment capacity in the jails.

<u>Superior Court – FIRS (CD-13) - \$848,000</u>

Move 3 existing staff in the FIRS program from General Fund to MIDD funding.
These positions are dedicated to the FIRS program and should have been part of the FIRS budget already.

District Court – Judicial Salary Increases - \$22,000 (the state sets these salaries)
