2018 King County Emergency Shelter and Services Outside Seattle Request for Proposals # 1012-18-VLN

Up to \$1 million in one-time funds was made available for operating support and supportive services for new or expanded shelter and services with the goal of increasing access to resources leading to housing stability for people experiencing homelessness in King County. Match from a jurisdiction was required for each project. Awards were made to seven programs across King County.
