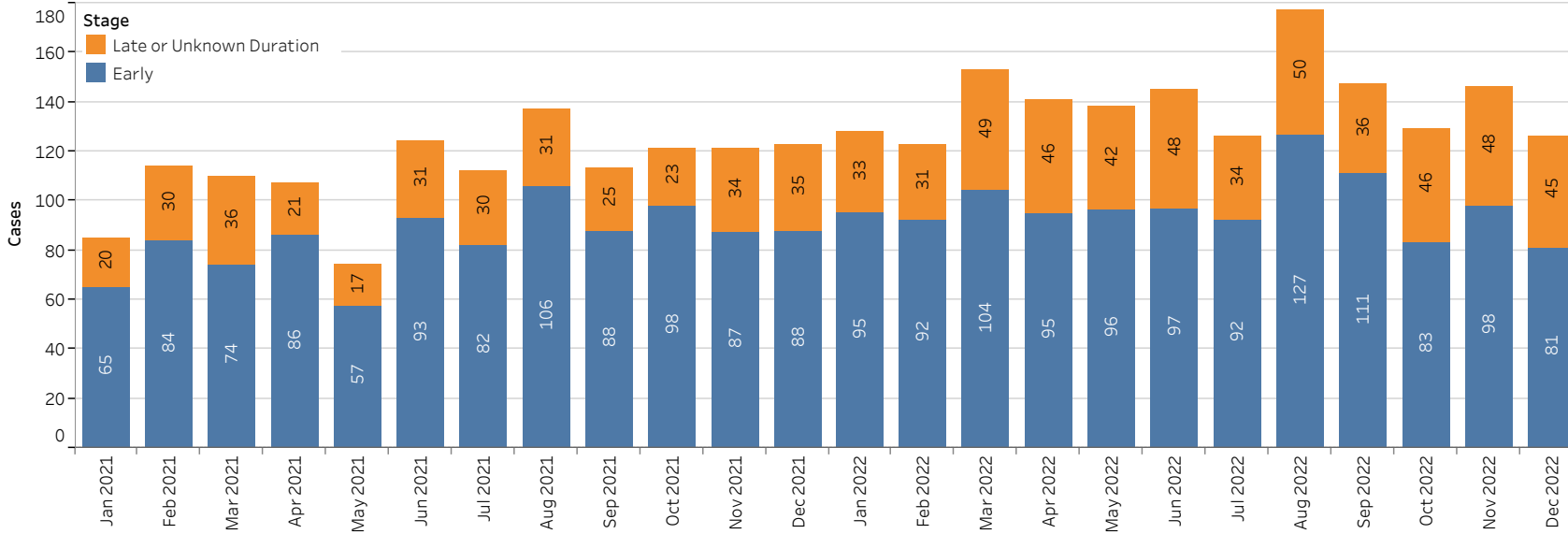

Syphilis Cases by Stage, King County January 2021-December 2022

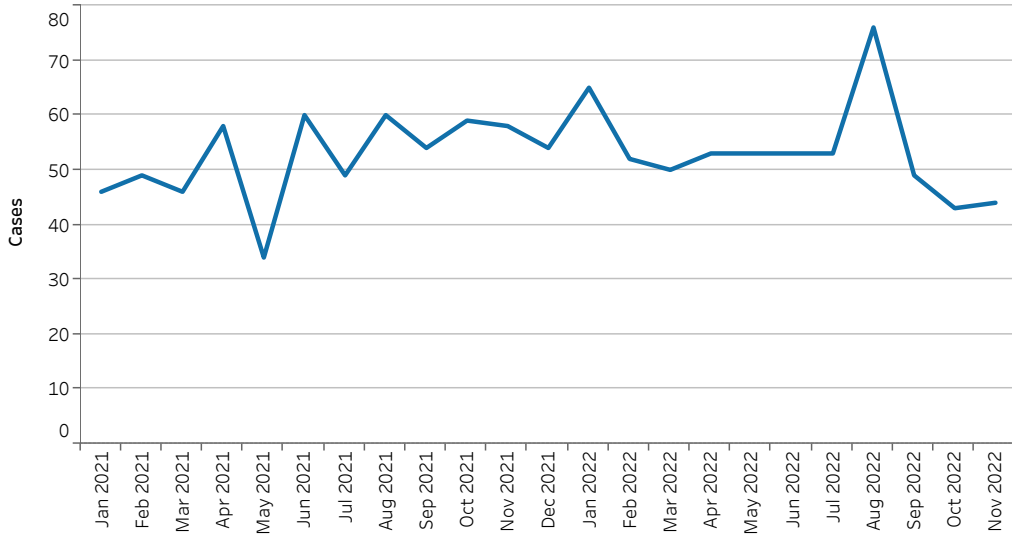

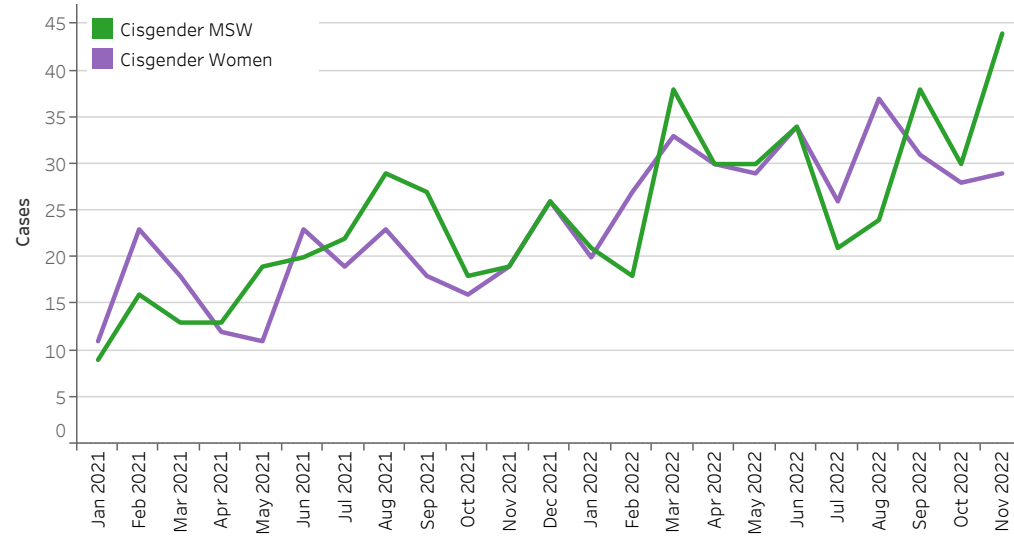
MSM = men who have sex with men

Syphilis (all stages) cases among cisgender men who have sex with women (MSW) and cisgender women, King County January 2021-November 2022**



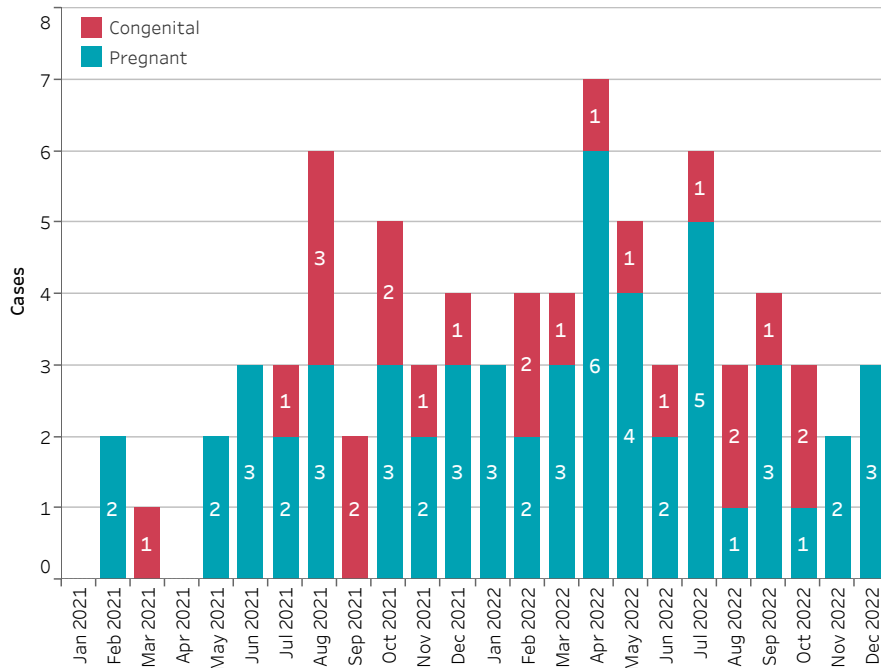

Pregnant and congenital syphilis cases, King County January 2021-December 2022



35 syphilis cases were **pregnant** at the time of diagnosis and **12 congenital** cases have been diagnosed in 2022.
