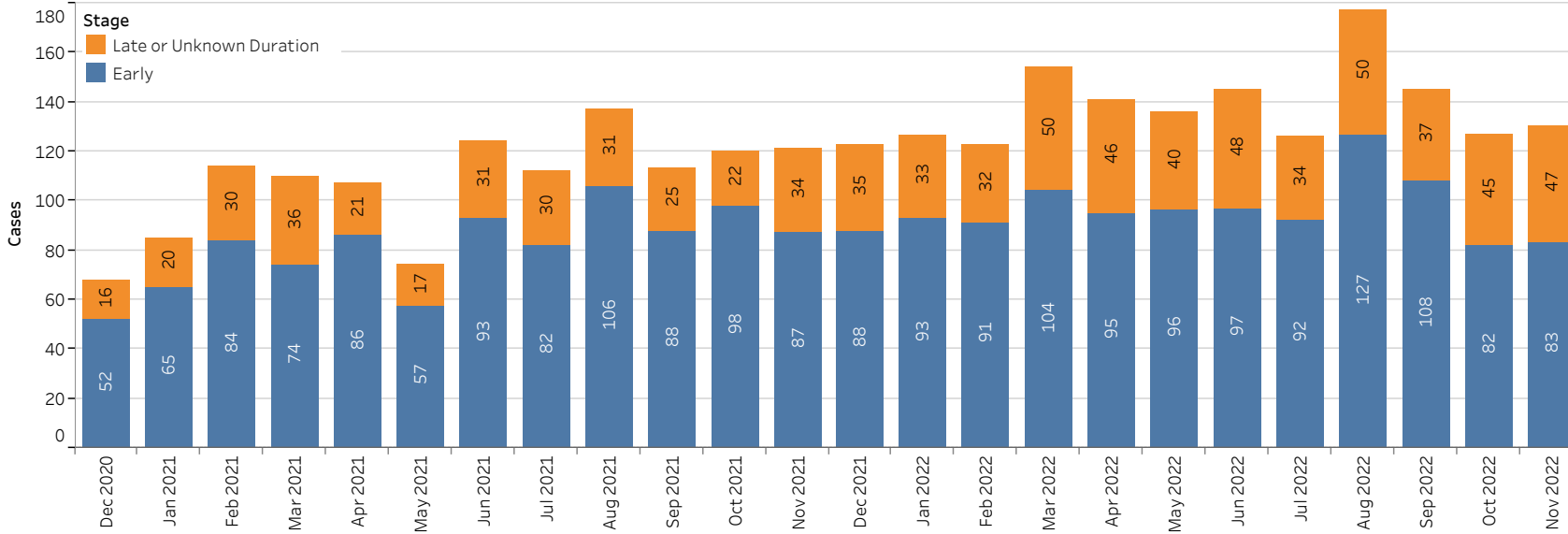

Syphilis Cases by Stage, King County December 2020-November 2022

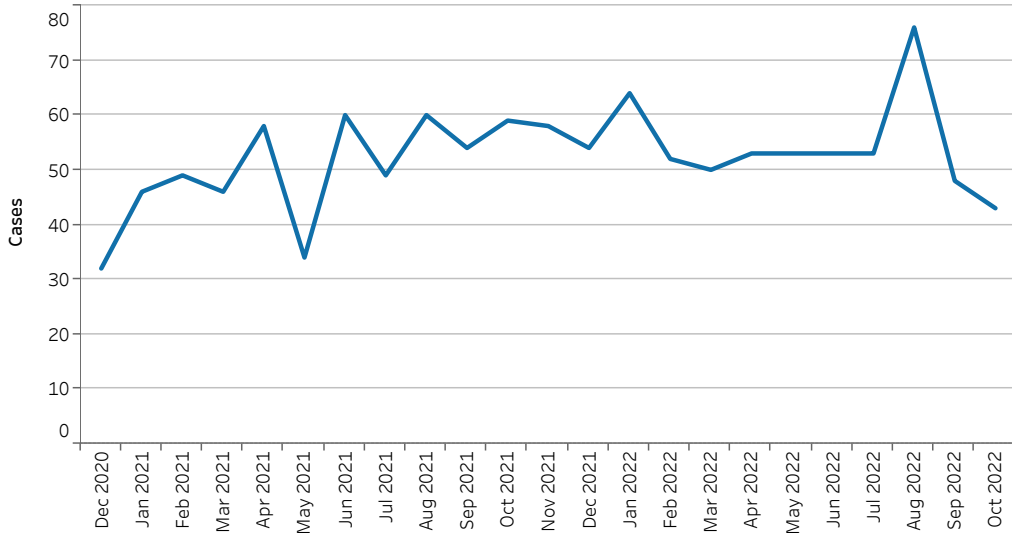

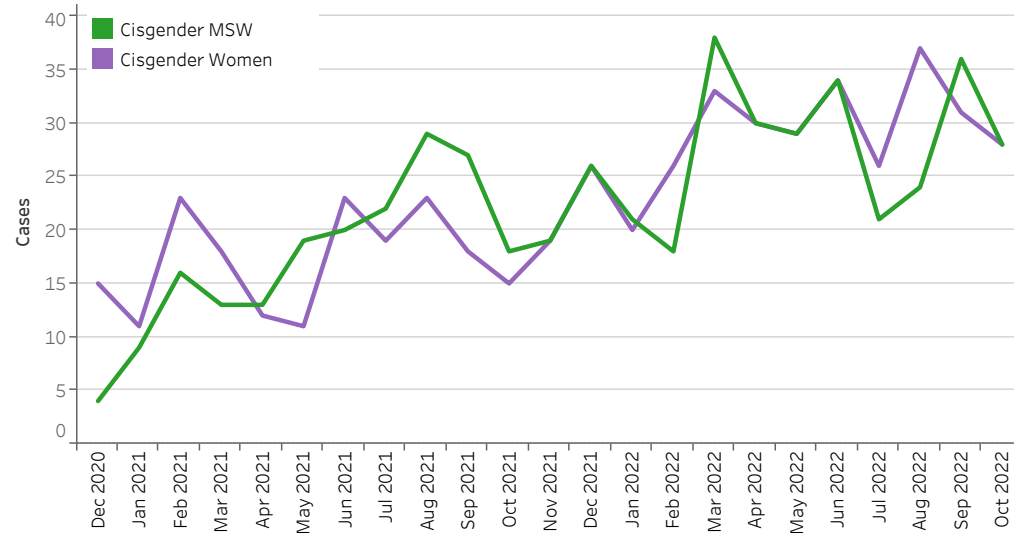
MSM = men who have sex with men

Syphilis (all stages) cases among cisgender men who have sex with women (MSW) and cisgender women, King County December 2020-October 2022**



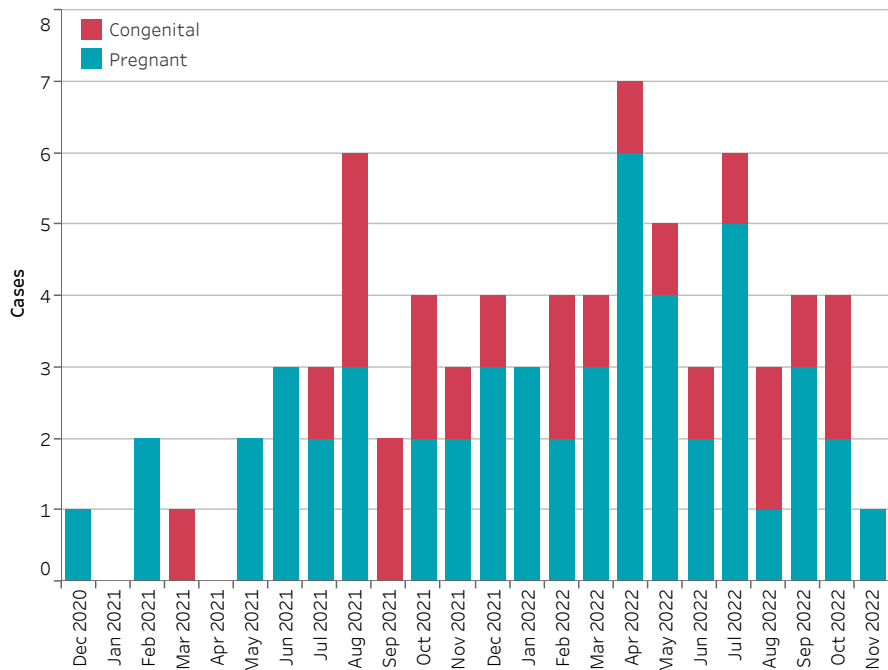
