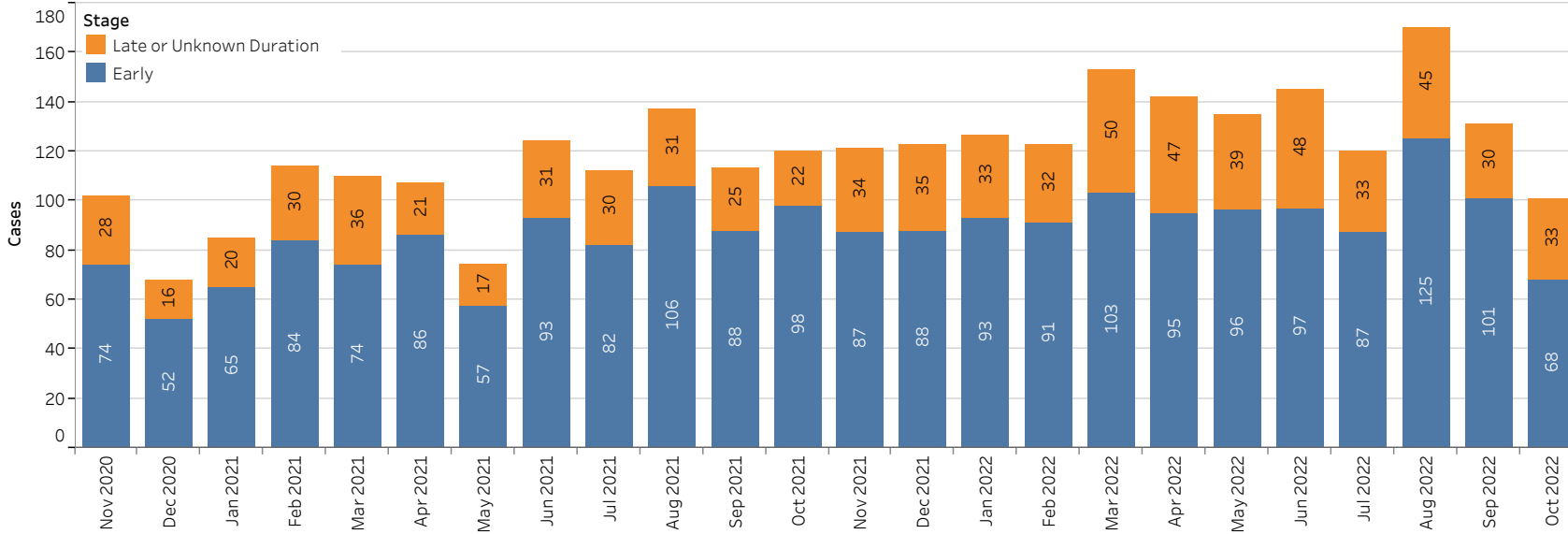


# Seattle and King County Monthly Syphilis Report: October 2022

**Syphilis Cases by Stage, King County November 2020-October 2022**

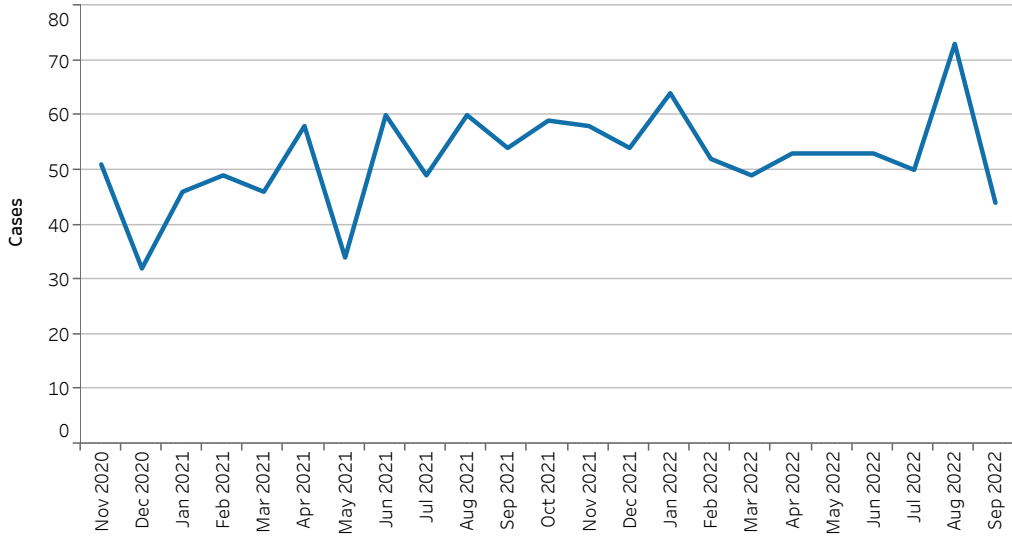

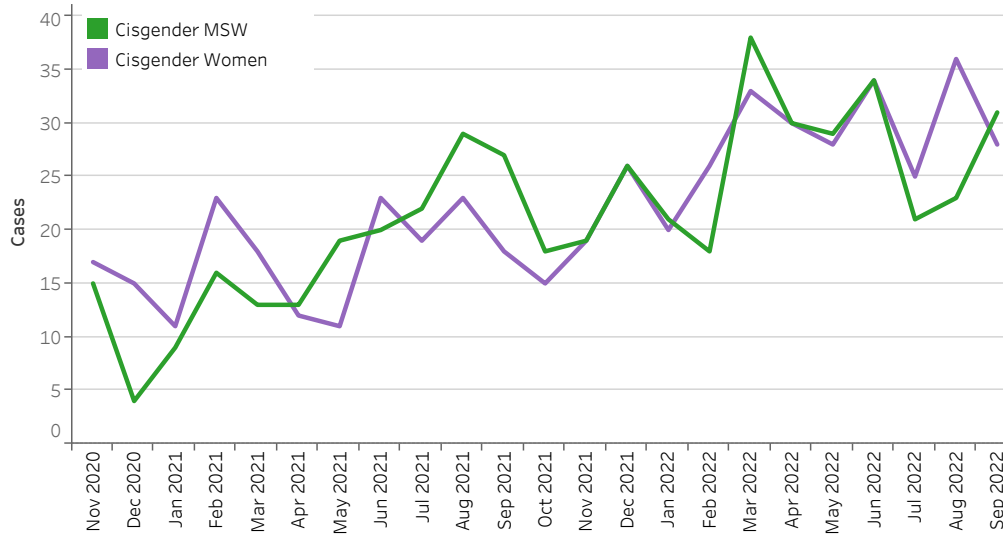
MSM = men who have sex with men

**Syphilis (all stages) cases among cisgender men who have sex with women (MSW) and cisgender women, King County November 2020-September 2022\*\***



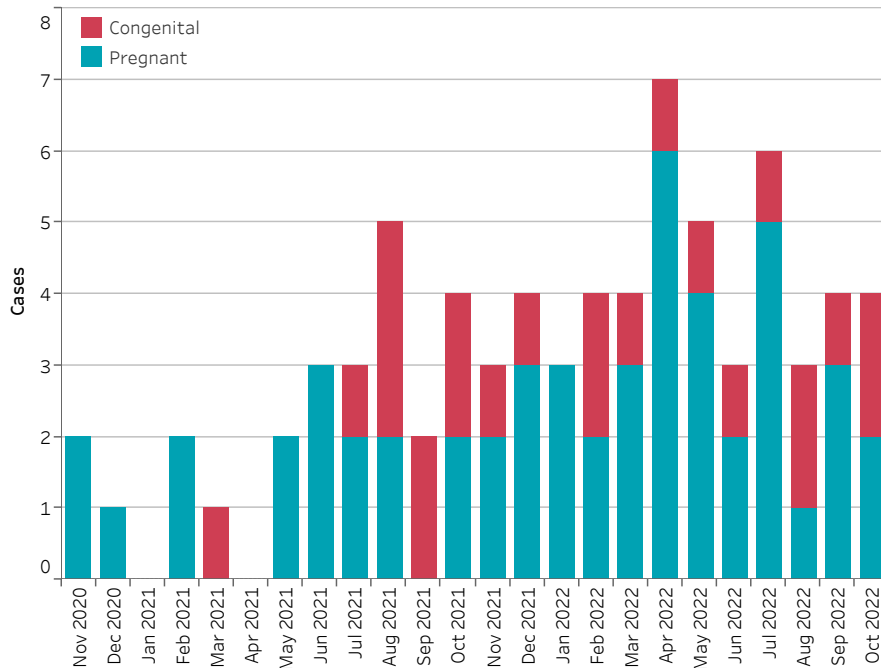
