





East Link Connections Project

New Local Route 225 - Phase 3

Neighborhoods Served:

- Kenmore, Kingsgate, Totem Lake, Redmond, Overlake

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Service will be reoriented to stay on 148th Ave NE from Old Redmond Road to NE 36th Street and will serve the Overlake Village Link Station before continuing to Overlake Park and Ride. The route will no longer serve Redmond Technology Station.
- This change will occur in 2023 with the opening of Link Light Rail to Redmond Technology Station.

Why is this change being proposed?

- To provide frequent service between Overlake Village Station and Old Redmond Road on 148th Ave NE when combined with new Route 223.

How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1 and Phase 2?

- Ensure transfers are easy and without interruption.

* Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

* Local - All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

* Peak-only - The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
