



Phase 3: Replaced Route 232

Routes 222, 250, 931 and Link light rail replace portions of Route 232

- Route 232 - Replaced peak-only route
- Replacement routes: 222, 250, 931
- East Link line & station
- Link (Angle Lake to Northgate) line & station
- Transit Center
- Permanent Park&Ride
- Half-mile walk buffer around East Link station
- Equity Priority Area



East Link Connections Project

Replaced Peak-Only Route 232- Phase 3

Neighborhoods Served:

- Duvall, Cottage Lake, Avondale, Redmond

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Revised 931 replaces the Route 232 from Duvall to Cottage Lake.
- New Route 222 replaces the Route 232 from Cottage Lake to NE 116th St.
- Link 2 Line replaces the Route 232 from Redmond to Bellevue.
- Revised Route 250 replaces Route 232 from NE 116th St to Redmond.
- These changes will occur in 2023 with the opening of Link Light Rail to Redmond Technology Station.

Why is this change being proposed?

- To provide a new connection from Duvall to Woodinville.
- To provide all day service between Cottage Lake, North Redmond, and Link service.
- To provide more direct connections to Redmond and Link service.

How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1 and Phase 2?

- Improve and add local connections.

* Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

* Local - All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

* Peak-only - The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
