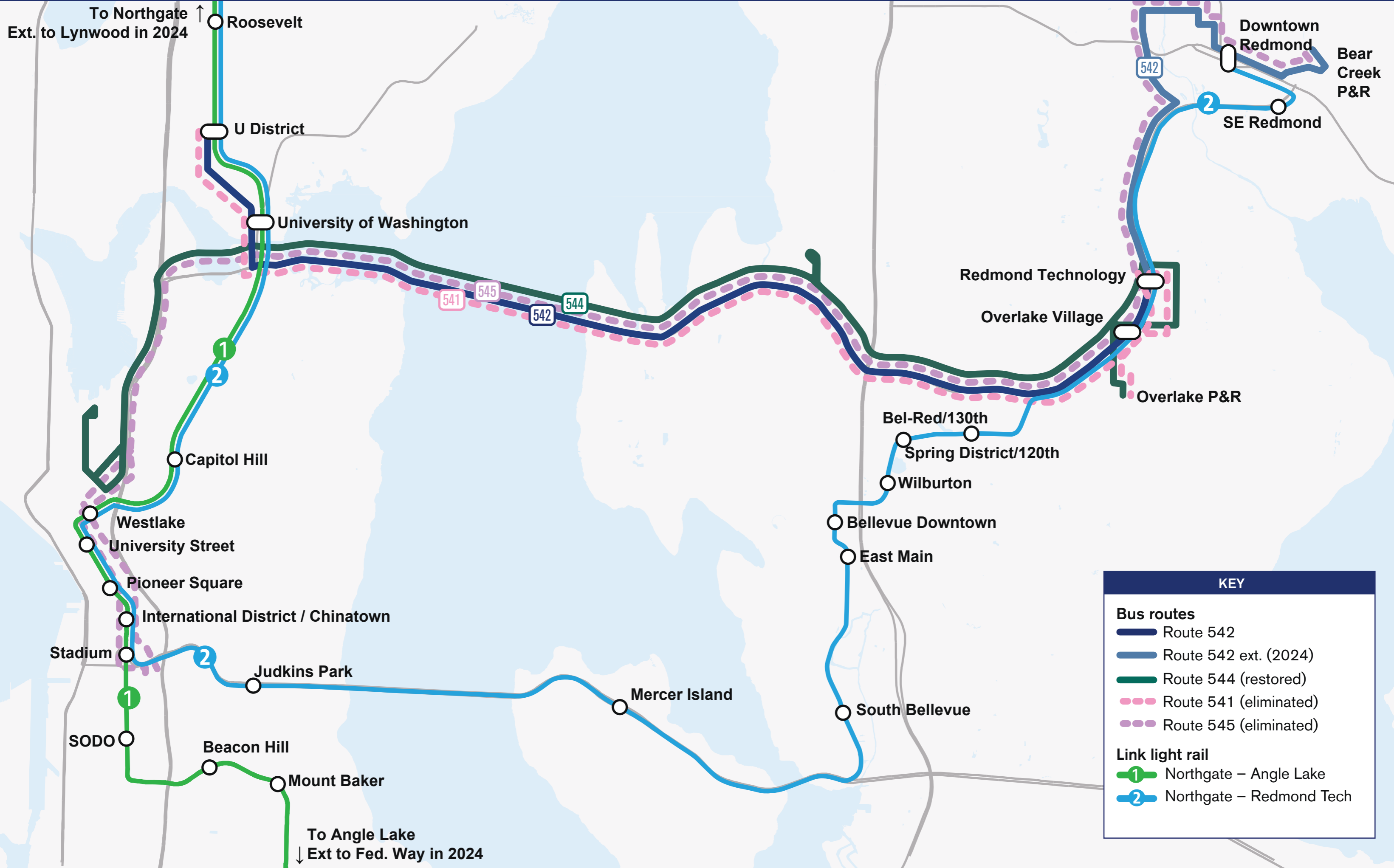


SR-520 Map (541/542/544/545)

Sound Transit Express Route 542 – Phase 3

Neighborhoods Served:

Redmond, Clyde Hill, Medina, Seattle

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Increase Route 542 service levels to provide connections to 2 Line at Redmond Technology Station.
- Extend eastern terminus to Bear Creek Park and Ride.

Why is this change being proposed?

- Route 542 will maintain connections & travel times across the SR-520 corridor.
- Provide connections in Remond to Link 2 Line.

How does this respond to feedback Sound Transit received in Phase 1 and 2?

- Faster travel times.
- Easier transfers to Link.

- * Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.
- * Local - All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.
- * Peak-only - The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
