Revised Peak Only Route 630 – Phase 3

Neighborhoods Served:

- Mercer Island, Judkins Park, Chinatown-International District, First Hill

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Revises Route 630 pathway to directly serve Seattle neighborhoods outside of downtown via Rainier Ave S, E Yesler Way, 9th Ave, Boren Ave, and E Jefferson St.

Why is this change being proposed?

- To directly serve First Hill hospitals, and other Seattle neighborhoods outside downtown.

How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1 and 2?

- It provides increased frequency during traditional peak commute hours.
- Minor routing revision on Seattle First Hill to streamline pathway.

* Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

* Local – All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

* Peak-only – The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
