Project Description: The proposal is to connect three existing single-family residences to a new well source.

Included is trenching of approximately 466' L.F. and boring of 180' under Harris Creek.

Permit requested in this application: Clearing & Grading

Consistency with applicable County plans and regulations: This proposal will be reviewed for compliance with all applicable King County codes including Roads Standards, Surface Water Design Manual, Zoning, Grading and Critical Areas Codes.

Other permits not included in this application, known at this time: King County Health Department Permit, Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife Hydraulic Project Approval (HPA)

King County Code requires notification of property owners within at least 500 feet of the project proposed above, so they can obtain additional information about the proposal and comment if they wish (KCC 20.20).

The Department of Local Services, Permitting Division will issue an Environmental Threshold Determination pursuant to the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) on this application following a **21-day public comment period** which ends on **Wednesday**, **November 24**, **2021**. The responsible official has a reasonable basis for expecting to issue a SEPA Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) on this project. As such, the optional DNS/MDNS notice process is being used pursuant to WAC 197-11-355. The project review process may incorporate or require mitigation measures regardless of whether an EIS is prepared.

This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal. Written comments on this application must be submitted to Permitting Division at the address above by the end of the comment period.
