Project Description: Repair an existing concrete bulkhead associated with a single-family residence on Lake Washington. The proposed repair work will consist of the following: drive 16 Manta Ray tie back anchors secured to a galvanized steel flat bar spanning the length of the waterward face of the bulkhead; fasten additional steel plates to both sections of the existing wall spanning over the cracked portion of concrete; remove backfill material and manually reset the concrete bulkhead back to its original location; install a filter fabric barrier behind the existing and place round drain rock (river rock) as backfill to help disperse runoff.

Permit requested in this application: Shoreline Exemption

Environmental review is required, and relevant environmental documents are available on-line at www.kingcounty.gov/permits, or at the above address.

Consistency with applicable County plans and regulations: This proposal will be reviewed for compliance with all applicable King County codes, including Critical Areas (KCC 21A.24) and the Shoreline Master Program (KCC 21A.25).

Other permits not included in this application, known at this time: None

King County Code requires notification of property owners within at least 500 feet of the project proposed above, so they can obtain additional information about the proposal and comment if they wish (KCC 20.20).

The Department of Local Services, Permitting Division will issue an Environmental Threshold Determination pursuant to the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) on this application following a **21-day public comment period** which ends on **July 3, 2023.** The responsible official has a reasonable basis for expecting to issue a SEPA Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) on this project. As such, the optional DNS/MDNS notice process is being used pursuant to WAC 197-11-355. The project review process may incorporate or require mitigation measures regardless of whether an EIS is prepared.

This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal. Written comments on this application must be submitted to Permitting Division at the address above by the end of the comment period.
