Project Location: I-90/SR 18 Interchange to Deep Creek. Shoreline work will occur at the SR 18 crossings of Raging River and Deep Creek.

Project Description: The proposed project will construct a diverging diamond interchange (DDI) at the I-90/SR 18 interchange and will widen SR 18 to four lanes from the interchange south to Deep Creek. SR 18 widening will occur at the crossings of Lake Creek, Raging River, and Deep Creek.

Permits requested in this application: Shoreline Substantial Development Permit (SSDP); Shoreline Conditional Use Permit (SCUP)

However, the Permitting decision may be appealed to the Shoreline Hearings Board, who would conduct an appeal hearing prior to making a decision on the appeal. Details of the appeal process will be included in the notice of decision.
