Project Description: Proposal to subdivide a 3.4-acre parcel, zoned R-4 (4 dwellings per acre) with an existing single family residence and wetland critical area into 5 single family lots, a wetland critical area tract, a combined stormwater/recreation tract, and a parcel for future development. The existing home will be retained.

The Department of Permitting and Environmental Review (DPER) will issue a written decision on this application following a 21-day public comment period which ends February 15, 2018 Written comments on this application must be submitted to DPER at the address above. A public hearing is not required for this application prior to the DPER decision. However, the DPER decision may be appealed to the King County Hearing Examiner, who would conduct an appeal hearing prior to making a decision on the appeal. Details of the appeal process will be included in the notice of decision.

This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal. The responsible official has a reasonable basis for expecting to issue a SEPA Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) on this project. As such, the optional DNS/MDNS notice process is being used pursuant to WAC 197-11-355. The project review process may incorporate or require mitigation measures regardless of whether an EIS is prepared.
