

## Landscape analysis of existing community level priorities

**Sources:** The sources used in this landscape review form part of ongoing and existing community engagement of King County departments with community-based organizations. These include reports from collaboration among departments and community-based organizations, networks, partnerships, interest groups, findings from surveys, focus groups, listening sessions, etc.

**Purpose:** Understand what collaboration exists among departments and communities related to the 14 Determinants of Equity report. Review of these resources has a twofold purpose: First and foremost, it will provide key information about the priorities of communities and the achievements/advances they have made in respect to these priorities. This analysis will also help identifying which groups are represented and which are not.

**Coding strategy:** We used an open coding strategy focusing on identifying major emergent themes that provided answers to the main following questions: 1. What are the needs of communities, including problems they face. 2. What are some of the potential solutions identified by communities, including goals and measures when available in the resources reviewed. 3. What are some of the mechanism communities have identified to improve, enhance, and better the quality of life of their members. Our landscape review also noted the composition of the community engagement by identifying type of community engagement, as well as population demographics when available.
