**TIME LIMITS TO REVOKE  
DEFERRED FINDINGS**

The Court will not act to revoke Orders Deferring Findings on Infractions more than three (3) years after the date of the Order of Deferral, when the violation of the order is a new offense, nor more than two (2) years after the Order of Deferral, where the sole violation of the order is failure to pay the court costs.

If the administrative fee has not been paid and more than three years have passed since entry of the Order of Deferral, the violation should be marked dismissed and the case closed. If the administrative fee has been paid and more than three years have passed since the Order of Deferral was signed, the charge shall be dismissed and case closed.
