) Clerical Dismissal of Disabled Placard
) Parking Infractions

King County District Court processes parking infractions citing no proof of disabled placard under RCW 46.19.050. The Court shall dismiss disabled placard parking infractions under 46.19.050(4) if the following requirements have been provided:

- A parking placards that includes both a serial number and the expiration date on the face of the placard, and the Department of Licensing individual with disabilities parking privilege card.
- The person cited must provide a statement under penalty of perjury that the placard, special license plate, or special year tab produced prior to the court appearance was valid at the time of infraction and that they were operating the vehicle or being transported at the time of the infraction under 46.19.050.

Therefore, it is now ORDERED:

If the above requirements have been provided to the Court, the clerk shall dismiss the disabled placard parking infraction administratively. If multiple charges exist on the ticket, this GAO only applies to the disabled placard parking charge. If all requirements have not been met, the clerk is ordered to refer the case to the judge for review.
