NOTES:

Through tax year 2022, the un-equalized levy rate for the State School Fund, which includes McCleary (Part2), is \$2.70, for an equalized rate for King County of \$3.08823. An approximate \$0.06 increase over last year.

The State Legislature, via ESSB 5313, increased the enhancement levies for local school districts from a maximum of \$1.50 in 2019 to a maximum of \$2.50/\$1,000. Included in that bill is an increase in the per student enrollment amount of \$1,500 per student enrollment to \$2,500 (\$3,000 for enrollment of 40,000+).
