Primary Contributing factors:

 Part 2 McCleary is exempt for qualifying senior/disabled citizens.

\* In 2023, King County voters approved a Crisis Care Center lid lift and a renewal of the Vets/HS/Srs lid lift, both of which are exempt for qualifying senior/disabled citizens.

\*Overall rate increase for SD 401 are primarily due to M&O and Bond levies beginning tax year 2023.

\*Increases in rates are typical when assessed values go down.
