3 In Attachment A, on page 2, strike lines 23 through 25 and insert:

4 **"E-106a King County shall recognize Indigenous Knowledge, also known as**  
5 **traditional ecological knowledge, as an important aspect in informing the**  
6 **development of rules, regulations, projects, and programs for the**  
7 **protection of critical areas and invite consultation with individual**  
8 **federally-recognized Indian tribes regarding the intended purpose,**  
9 **sharing, and application of Indigenous Knowledge to inform protection of**  
10 **critical areas."**

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12 In Attachment A, on page 2, strike lines 56 and 57 and insert:

13 **" E-334a King County should actively communicate and invite consultation with**  
14 **federally-recognized Indian tribes regarding potential impact to species**  
15 **and habitats of cultural importance to Indian tribes in its planning,**  
16 **development review, and capital projects."**

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18 **EFFECT prepared by J. Ngo:** The amendment would invite consultation with federally  
19 recognized Indian tribes on two proposed policies in the Comprehensive Plan related to  
20 Indigenous Knowledge and species and habitats of cultural importance.

21 Policy E-106 would be revised as follows:

22 **E-106a King County shall recognize Indigenous Knowledge, also known as**  
23 **traditional ecological knowledge, as an important aspect in informing the**  
24 **development of rules, regulations, projects, and programs for the**  
25 **protection of critical areas and invite consultation with individual federally**  
26 **recognized Indian tribes regarding the intended purpose, sharing, and**  
27 **application of Indigenous Knowledge to inform protection of critical areas.**

28 Policy E-334a would be revised as follows:

29        **E-334a        King County should actively communicate and invite consultation with**  
30        **federally recognized Indian tribes regarding potential impact to consider**  
31        **species and habitats of cultural importance to Indian tribes in its planning,**  
32        **development review, and capital projects.**
