Staffer Mondaca gave an overview of the workgroup's 2024 workplan and asked members if there were any additional materials they would like to cover regarding the first focus - complaints and investigation process. Chair Hays said that he would like to compare KCE's complaint processing and investigation procedure with other jurisdictions.
