Emergency Financial Assistance

SCOPE may provide financial assistance to King County residents to help them gain or retain employment, support educational goals leading to employment, or meet basic needs.

Emergency financial assistance can help with one-time needs such as:

- Education: Book fees, transportation, and other school related costs
- Employment: Permit/license fees, job search assistance, transportation
- Basic needs: groceries, healthcare, gas, childcare

SCOPE Financial Assistance is intended for emergent or one-time situations and not intended for recurrent or regular needs.

SCOPE does not provide rent or mortgage assistance.

Eligibility for Emergency Financial Assistance

To receive emergency financial assistance you must:

- Be 18 years or older
- Show proof of identity
- Reside or shelter in King County and show proof of residency
- Show proof of need
- Show proof of income
- Enroll in SCOPE's resource navigation services, including a financial crisis mitigation plan
