\*Finding out that there is no system in place that protects a DDA population over the age of 18 in jail

\*Even with the parents being an appointed legal guardian the family had no rights or ability to help, or have any communication with the lawyers or their son

\*Finally a social worker obtained an ROI for communication

Candace-

\*We are in need of all Tri-leads for the FYSPRT

\*Needing people to volunteer in meetings

\*We need more families and attendees

\*Need the meetings to be more family centered

Carolyn Cox-

\*Asked about Spark going into recovery schools. Candace will talk to LaTonya

\*Recovery schools are a great addition to our communities

\*Spark is going into schools to recruit youth for peer roles, depending on outcome of training

\* After the youth goes through classes their name is sent to the HCA for peer certification

\*Spark will support youth any way they can to become part of the peer workforce
