10 attendees participated throughout the duration of this month's meeting. LeChez assisted with facilitation alongside Pattie. The meeting started off with introductions and an icebreaker, Land Acknowledgement, and Comfort Agreement Review.

Jackie shared an update with the community that KC3 would be ending the contract with GPS by the end of July so the KC Regional FYSPRT can go up for public bid. This decision was made due to convenience for the county.

After checking in to see if anyone had any community input and concerns, the meeting was handed over to Karen Kelly from WSCC for a System of Care Training. A parent in the room voiced their intention to reach out to Kelly to learn more.
