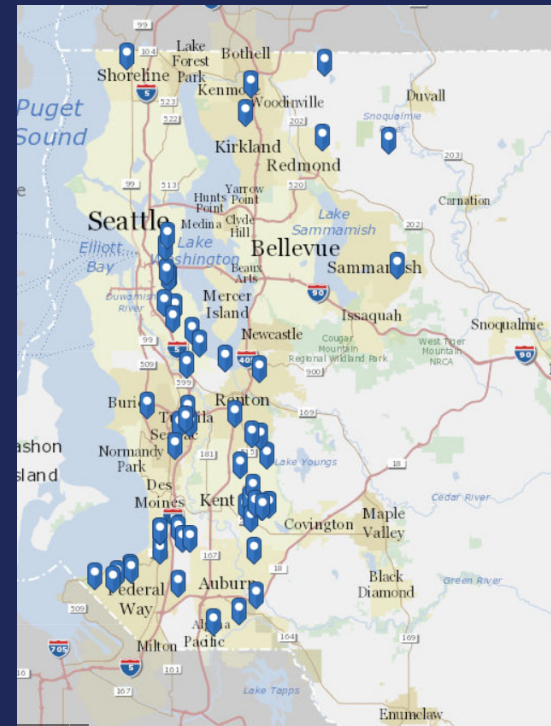

- Program Model - culturally relevant programming, trauma informed care, meeting the diverse needs of children served, and meeting the needs of their community.
