

Universal Developmental Screening & Promotion: 2025 Year in Review

Universal Developmental Screening & Promotion (UDSP) programs provide information, training, and connections to services. UDSP's goal is to make sure all King County children receive culturally-appropriate, high-quality developmental screenings. In 2025, UDSP served **477 caregivers** and **1,787 children** with screenings and referrals. Programs **screened 1,303 of those children** and made **1,505 warm connections to services**. Providers also held **550 events** on developmental topics and **reached 1,222 people**.

“One caregiver shared that for the first time, she felt ‘seen and respected’ rather than judged. She explained that the screening conversation helped her reflect on her own childhood experiences and how she wants to parent differently.”
