

# Behavioral Supports: 2025 Year in Review

The DCHS Developmental Disabilities & Early Childhood Supports Division funds two behavioral health programs for young people with Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities (I/DD). The MultiCare Behavior Support Team (BeST) program helps families manage everyday behavioral concerns. The YMCA Crisis Outreach Response System Developmental Disabilities (CORS-DD) team provides rapid support to young people with I/DD who have behavioral health needs. In 2025, 42 young people and their families were served by BeST and CORS-DD.

**83%**

of all families engaged in the BeST program plan to continue using tools shared by the program

**100%**

of BeST participants had positive outcomes, stabilization, or met behavior goals when they exited the program

**77%**

of CORS-DD participants were connected with additional services when they exited the program

**94%**

of CORS-DD participants engaged had positive outcomes or stabilization when they exited the program
