

# Community Information, Outreach & Supports Network: 2025 Year in Review

## Information, Referral & Cultural Navigation



Information & Referral (I&R) programs connect people with Intellectual or Developmental Disabilities (I/DD) and their families with needed services. In 2025, I&R programs helped with 2,505 requests for services.

# 74%

of people who got help from a cultural navigator speak a language other than English

# 84%

of total I&R program referrals resulted in people getting the help or connection to services they were looking for

## Community Outreach, Education & Civic Engagement

The Self Advocacy Leadership Training (SALT) Program provides one-of-a-kind leadership training for young adults with I/DD

Community Outreach, Education, and Civic Engagement programs reached 1,655 people through trainings and 518 people through peer support groups. Eleven young people with I/DD learned leadership skills through the SALT Program.
