

# Community Inclusion

## Data Highlights

Community Inclusion (CI) services help people with intellectual or developmental disabilities (I/DD) take part in activities in their community that match their interests. These activities are not just for people with I/DD, but connect all members of the community together. These activities can include social clubs for people with shared interests, classes on a variety of topics, or volunteering opportunities. The goal is to help individuals build relationships with others, while practicing everyday skills that help support independence and connections to their community.

### In 2025...

Approx.

**500** participants received CI services from a provider in King County

**20%** increase in CI participants between 2024 and 2025

**37%** of CI participants also receiving supported employment services

**94%** of surveyed CI participants satisfied with services
