Family Law Case Schedule Changes: Emergency Changes to the Confirmation of Issues Form and Status Conference (LFLR 4)

Confirmation of Issues

Effective immediately the Confirmation of Issues form has changed. The new form is available at: <https://kingcounty.gov/courts/clerk/forms.aspx>.

- This form is no longer required for cases that do not involve minor children.
- The form can now be filed unilaterally. A form signed by both parties (jointly) is no longer required.

Status Conference and Noncompliance Hearings

Parties are no longer required to appear for the Status Conference or previously scheduled Noncompliance Hearings. Cases will be reviewed administratively, and parties will be notified by mail if their case is not in compliance with the Case Schedule. Cases without proper service, or adequate cause when required, may be ordered to appear at a hearing by phone to explain (show cause) why the case should not be dismissed. Instructions on how to appear for the show cause hearing will be included in the order.
