King County Superior Court Clerk's Office Systems Replacement Project – KC Script Portal and Webinar Information

Today, March 28, 2022, the King County Superior Court Clerk's Office/Department of Judicial Administration launched the new <u>KC Script Portal</u>. The KC Script Portal replaces the ECR (Electronic Court Records) Online and Electronic Records Requests (ERR) applications.

In the <u>KC Script Portal</u> customers can now order copies of court records, recordings of court hearings, request research assistance and much more.
