Changes to the Ex Parte Calendar

Effective immediately, there are changes to the Ex Parte Department calendars. All hearings noted on open calendars through August 10, 2022, using the prior calendaring availability system, will be added to the department's calendar. Any matters noted August 11, 2022 or later, which do not meet existing calendaring criteria, will need to be rescheduled by the moving party, unless the hearing has been set by court order.

Effective immediately, a new Notice of Court Date – Ex Parte should be used to set all future hearings in the King County Superior Court Ex Parte department, except those set by court order. Using the incorrect Notice of Court Date form may result in your hearing not being set on the docket and/or not being heard.
