Catherine Cornwall Appointed King County Superior Court Clerk

King County Superior Court Presiding Judge Patrick Oishi recently announced the appointment of Catherine Cornwall to the position of Department of Judicial Administration (DJA) Director and Superior Court Clerk. Ms. Cornwall will assume this role immediately following the retirement of Barbara Miner on July 21, 2023.

Ms. Cornwall has served as the Deputy Director of DJA since 2022.
