What is Drug Court?

Drug Court is different from other court experiences. Our goal is to help you. We give you the support, accountability, structure and resources you need.

When you complete the program, you can get your felony charges dismissed and avoid prison time.

Is Drug Court for me?

You can try out Drug Court before deciding you want to commit to the program. During that time, you will have full access to treatment, housing and other resources the program provides.

During Phase 1, if you decide not to participate in the Drug Court program, you can leave and take your case to the mainstream legal system instead.

There are eligibility requirements to participate. The program is for adults charged with certain felony property crimes and other drugrelated felony crimes in King County.

Drug Court is more than just drug and alcohol treatment. The program can help you stop using, stay out of jail and achieve your goals.

We Provide:



ACCESS TO RESOURCES

- FREE housing, transportation, cell phone, clothing and basic needs, dental and medical care, and medications (including methadone and suboxone).
- Help getting your driver's license, GED, college, employment, etc.
- Access to funds to help pay restitution on your drug court cases.

WELL-ROUNDED SUPPORT

- Support from case managers and peers.
- Connection to drug court graduates and others who have been through what you've been through.
- Being around positive people who encourage you.
- Help navigating other legal matters including warrant quashes.

HELP WITH RECOVERY

- FREE treatment including access to inpatient.
- Gain self-confidence, self-awareness, and an understanding of recovery.
