Quarterly Report Summary

King County Superior Court

NOTE: Washington State Supreme Court orders related to the coronavirus pandemic, beginning March 2020, affect the statistics for the foreseeable future.

Highlights


- <u>Criminal Cases</u> -- The criminal filings in the first quarter of 2022 were almost the same as that in 2021, differing only by 2 cases. The criminal filings (excluding RALJ) in the first quarter of 2022 were 1,196 cases, with MRJC accounting for 38% of the total cases. The number of resolutions of criminal cases in the first quarter of 2022 was 1,103 cases. The pending criminal caseload at the end of the first quarter of 2022 was 4,808 cases (excluding RALJ). Of the 4,808 pending criminal cases, 43% were the MRJC cases.
- *Civil Cases*. Filings in civil cases (case type 2) in the first quarter of 2022 were comparable to that in 2021 (+1.0%). The civil resolutions matched the filing volume in the same period. The pending civil caseload was 6,164 cases at the end of the first quarter of 2022, a low volume. MRJC had 33% of the civil pending caseload.
- **Domestic Cases.** Domestic case (case type 3) filings in the first quarter of 2022 were slightly lower than that in 2021 (-4%), totaling 1,466 cases. The resolutions of domestic cases exceeded the filing volume in the same period. The pending domestic caseload was 4,270 cases at the end of the first quarter of 2022, with 41% being the MRJC cases.
- <u>ITA Cases</u>. The filings of ITA cases in 2022 remained at a high level. A total of 1,337 ITA cases were filed in the first quarter of 2022, up 1.8% from the same period in 2021. The number of ITA cases remaining to be adjudicated at the end of the first quarter of 2022 was 633 cases, a very large volume.
- Juvenile Dependency/Termination (DEP/TER) and At-risk Youth (ARY)/Child-in-Need of Service (CHINS)


 Cases. In the first quarter of 2022, the filing volume in juvenile-related categories showed different patterns pattern when compared to that in 2021: dependency filings up by 16.2%, termination down by 15.2% (-15.2), and ARY/CHINS/others down by 25% (-25%). Court also started to receive truancy cases after a pause during the Covid pandemic. At the end of the first quarter of 2022, there were 279 dependency cases, 224 termination cases, and 102 ARY/CHINS/Other cases pending resolution.
- Juvenile Offender Cases. The juvenile offender filings in 2022 remains low. In the first quarter of 2022, 100 offender cases were filed, a 21.3% decrease from 2021. The resolution pace for juvenile offender cases was slower than the filing pace in the same period. At the end of the first quarter of 2022, there were 233 juvenile offender pending cases, an extremely low volume.
- **Pro Tem Use.** In the first quarter of 2022, the daily Pro Tem use by the court was 2 FTEs.
- **Post-resolution Modifications (Table 1-A).** In the first quarter of 2022, there were 150 post-resolution modifications filed (both parenting plan and relocation modifications).
- Active re-opened cases and family law modification cases (Table 4-A). At the end of the first quarter of 2022, there were 590 active re-opened cases and 487 active family law modification cases.



In a jury case, it also includes the selection of the jury. A trial can be held for one or more cases. A single trial may be held to adjudicate more than one case (as defined above).
