# **Quarterly Report Summary**

King County Superior Court

#### NOTE: Washington State Supreme Court orders related to the coronavirus pandemic, beginning March 2020, affect the statistics for the foreseeable future.

#### <u>Highlights</u>

- <u>Criminal Cases</u> -- The criminal filings in 2022 were higher than in 2021, showing a 6.4% increase from 2021. The total criminal case filings (excluding RALJ) in 2022 were 4,956 cases, with MRJC accounting for 38% of the total cases. The resolutions of criminal cases in 2022 was 4,727 cases, slightly lower than the filing volume. The pending criminal caseload at the end of December 2022 was 4,298 cases (excluding RALJ). Of the 4,298 pending criminal cases, 41% were the MRJC cases.
- <u>*Civil Cases.*</u> Filings in civil cases (case type 2) in 2022 were higher than 2021 as well (+15.6%). The civil resolutions were slightly lower than the filing volume in the same period. The pending civil caseload was 6,799 cases at the end of December 2022, a low volume. MRJC had 33% of the pending civil caseload.
- <u>Domestic Cases</u>. Domestic case (case type 3) filings in 2022 were slightly lower than 2021 (-3.0%), totaling 5,999 cases. The resolutions of domestic cases exceeded the filing volume in the same period. The pending domestic caseload was 4,281 cases at the end of December 2022, with 41% being the MRJC cases.
- <u>ITA Cases</u>. The filings of ITA cases in 2022 continued an upward trend and with a high volume. A total of 5,665 ITA cases were filed in 2022, up 9.8% from 2021. The number of ITA cases remaining to be adjudicated at the end of December 2022 was 282 cases.
- Juvenile Dependency/Termination (DEP/TER) and At-risk Youth (ARY)/Child-in-Need of Service (CHINS) <u>Cases</u>. In 2022, the filing volume in juvenile-related categories showed different patterns when compared to that in 2021: dependency filings were up 4.4% from 2021, termination down 8.3%, and ARY/CHINS/others up 19.9%. Court also started to receive a significant number of truancy cases in 2022 after a pause during the Covid pandemic. At the end of December 2022, there were 279 dependency cases, 265 termination cases, and 158 ARY/CHINS/Other cases pending resolution.
- <u>Juvenile Offender Cases</u>. The juvenile offender filings in 2022 increased significantly from 2021. In 2022, 500 offender cases were filed, showing a 40% increase from 2021. The resolution pace for juvenile offender cases was slower than the filing pace in the same period. At the end of the December 2022, there were 301 juvenile offender pending cases.
- <u>Pro Tem Use</u>. In the four quarters of 2022, the daily Pro Tem use by the court was 2.0, 4.8, 4.5, and 2.5 FTEs, respectively. In addition, the court also employed 6.4 TLT and used a significant amount (5.7 FTEs in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2022) of Pro Tems on CLFRF backlog reduction.
- *Post-resolution Modifications (Table 1-A).* In 2022, there were 565 post-resolution modifications filed (both parenting plan and relocation modifications).
- <u>Active re-opened cases and family law modification cases (Table 4-A)</u>. At the end of December 2022, there were 806 active re-opened cases and 501 active family law modification cases.



#### Resolution

A case is resolved if all issues in the complaint are fully adjudicated.

#### Suspended Case

#### Suspense Status

#### Trial

A hearing set before a judge or jury in which all the issues in the case are meant to be resolved. A trial normally includes opening statements to the court or jury stating what evidence will show, introduction of witnesses and exhibits for direct and cross examination, final arguments to the court or jury in which counsel argue both the evidence and the law, and judgment by the court or jury stating what the facts of the case are and what law applies to the facts. In a jury case, it also includes the selection of the jury. A trial can be held for one or more cases. A single trial may be held to adjudicate more than one case (as defined above).
