## Summary

### **Filings:**

ITA filings continue to increase and remain at a high level. In 2022, the total ITA filings reached a historical high of 5,665 cases. It is worth noting that the petitions filed by families (Joel's law cases) have gradually increased since the action was implemented. The average filings were 472 cases per month.

In 2023, a total of 5,541 ITA cases were filed, just a slightly lower than the historical high in 2022. Of the 5,541 ITA cases received in 2023, 82 ITA petitions were filed by families, and 668 were from other jurisdictions. The monthly average of filings in 2023 were 462 cases.

In the first quarter of 2024, 1,391 ITA cases were filed, averaging 463 cases per month. This compares with the monthly average of 472 and 462 cases filed in 2022 and 2023, respectively.

### **Resolutions:**

The resolutions of ITA cases matched with the increasing trend in ITA filings in recent years. The median time (50%tile) to reach resolution has consistently been under 2 weeks.

In the first quarter of 2024, the court resolved 1,437 ITA cases, averaging 479 cases per month. This compares with an average of 493 and 451 cases resolved per month in 2022 and 2023, respectively.

### **Pending:**

Because the resolution pace of ITA has matched with the filing volume, the pending active ITA cases remain at a reasonable level. At the end of the first quarter of 2024, there are 362 ITA cases pending resolution.

### **Orders:**

There have been a significant number of ITA orders every quarter. There were 4,650 and 4,532 ITA orders entered per quarter in 2021 and 2022, respectively. In 2023, an average of 4,260 ITA orders were entered per quarter. In the first quarter of 2024, the court issued a total of 4,263 ITA orders.

### **Hearings:**

The number of ITA hearings varies from quarter to quarter. In 2022, there were 255 ITA hearings per quarter on average. In 2023, the court held 287 ITA hearings per quarter on average. In the first quarter of 2024, there were 215 ITA hearings.

## Terminology

### **Filing**

The number of petitions filed, initiating new ITA cases during the reporting period.

### **Resolution**

The number of petitions (cases) resolved, either by “approval” or “dismissal” order during the reporting period.

An ITA case has been resolved when the Court enters a 14-Day, 90-Day, or 180-Day Order of Detention, Less Restrictive Alternative, or when the Court enters an Order of Dismissal.

Unlike the definition of “resolution” for other Superior Court case types, the “resolution” for these case categories may not indicate the end of judicial involvement when the petition is approved.

### **Pending Resolution**

The number of active cases that have not been resolved, namely, the petition has neither been approved nor dismissed yet.

### **Completion**

ITA cases are completed when a Notice of Release, Notice of Completion of Program, or an Order of Dismissal are filed. When an Order of Dismissal or Notice of Release is filed, and the case has not been resolved by a previous Order, the Order of Dismissal or Notice of Release will resolve and complete the case.

### **Pending Completion**

Indicates the number of cases for which the petition has been approved, but issues (sometimes significant issues) remain in which the court may become actively involved.

### **Resolution Age**

Is the time (days) from filing to resolution, less suspense time if applicable.

### **Pending Resolution Case Age**

Indicates the time (days) from filing to the last day of the reporting period for these cases that remain unresolved (no approval or dismissal of the petition), less suspense time, if applicable.

### **Number of Petitions**

The total number of petitions entered during the reporting period.

### **Number of Orders**

The total number of orders entered during the reporting period.

### **Number of Hearings**

The total number of hearings held other than fact-findings during the reporting period.
