


- <u>Criminal Cases</u>. The criminal filings in 2024 were 5,169 cases, showing a 5.6% increase from 2023 (+5.6%). MRJC accounted for 43% of the criminal cases filed in 2024. The resolutions of criminal cases in 2024 matched the filing pace, totaling 5,347 cases. The pending criminal caseload has stayed around 4,000 cases in the last 12 months. At the end of 2024, 4,034 criminal cases (excluding RALJ) remained active. Of the 4,034 pending criminal cases, 43% were the MRJC cases.
- <u>Civil Cases</u>. Filings in civil cases (case type 2) continued an upwards trend since the third quarter of 2023. The filings in case type 2 (general civil) in 2024 were significantly higher than that in 2023, showing a 25.7% increase from 2023 and totaling 24,855 cases. The increase in civil filings was primarily due to the rise in unlawful detainer cases and civil protection petitions. MRJC accounted for 43% of the civil cases filed in 2024. The overall civil resolutions were lower than the filing volume in the same period, resulting an increase in active civil pending caseload. At the end of 2024, there were 9,332 civil cases pending disposition. The MRJC had 37% of the pending civil caseload at the end of 2024.
- <u>Domestic Cases</u>. Domestic case (case type 3) filings in 2024 were comparable with that in 2023, with 2.6% increase only. A total of 6,533 domestic cases were filed in 2024, and 38% were filed in the MRJC. The resolutions of domestic cases fell slightly behind the filing volume in 2024. At the end of 2024, the pending domestic caseload was 4,649 cases, with 41% being the MRJC cases.
- <u>ITA Cases</u>. The filings of ITA cases in 2024 remained at a high level, but seemed to have reached a plateau. A total of 5,438 ITA cases were filed in 2024, just slightly lower than that in 2023 (-1.9%). The ITA filing volume remains over 5,000 cases in the last 5 years. There were 452 ITA cases remaining to be adjudicated at the end of 2024.
- Juvenile Dependency/Termination (DEP/TER) and At-risk Youth (ARY)/Child-in-Need of Service (CHINS) Cases. In 2024, termination filings were down 24% from 2023. On the other hand, filings in dependency, ARY/CHINS/others were up 39%, and 48% respectively from 2023. At the end of 2024, the numbers of cases pending disposition in the non-Offense juvenile categories were: 333 dependency cases, 97 termination cases, 219 ARY/CHINS/Other cases, and 1,865 truancy cases.
- <u>Juvenile Offense Cases</u>. The juvenile offense filings in 2024 increased significantly from 2023, with a total of 941 juvenile offense cases filed in 2024. The juvenile offense filings in 2024 were 30% higher than in 2023. The court disposed 827 juvenile offense cases, slightly behind the filing pace in the year. At the end of 2024, there were 417 pending juvenile offense cases.
- **Pro Tem Use.** In the four quarters of 2024, the daily Pro Tem use by the court was 4.2, 5.5, 3.3, and 4.4 FTEs on average, respectively.
- <u>Post-resolution Modifications (Table 1-A)</u>. In 2024, there were 467 post-resolution modifications filed (both parenting plan and relocation modifications).
- <u>Active re-opened cases and family law modification cases (Table 4-A)</u>. At the end of 2024, 939 re-opened cases and 362 family law modification cases remained active.



Glossary and Definition

Active Status

A case is active if it is not on suspense status (see Suspense Status).

Completion

A case is completed if dispositive document is filed with the court following resolution.

Jury Trial

A hearing is reported as a jury trial if the jury is impaneled.

Non-Jury Trial

A hearing is reported as a non-jury trial if an opening statement is made, waived, or reserved.

Pending Case

A case is defined as pending if it is unresolved and active (not in suspense).

Post-disposition Modifications

Petition to modify parenting plan after the resolution of the original case, based on the modification schedule.

Resolution

A case is resolved if all issues in the complaint are fully adjudicated.

Suspended Case

A case is placed in suspense status from active status during the reporting period.

Suspense Status

A case is on suspense status if it is on warrant, appeal, stay, mediation, arbitration ("Deferred Prosecution" is not a suspense status, but is treated as a resolution).

Trial

A hearing set before a judge or jury in which all the issues in the case are meant to be resolved. A trial normally includes opening statements to the court or jury stating what evidence will show, introduction of witnesses and exhibits for direct and cross examination, final arguments to the court or jury in which counsel argue both the evidence and the law, and judgment by the court or jury stating what the facts of the case are and what law applies to the facts. In a jury case, it also includes the selection of the jury. A trial can be held for one or more cases. A single trial may be held to adjudicate more than one case (as defined above).
