
Quarterly Report Summary


- <u>Criminal Cases</u>. The criminal filings in the first three quarters of 2025 were 4,082 cases, showing a 4.5% increase from 2024 (+4.5%). MRJC accounted for 40% of the criminal cases filed in 2025. The resolutions of criminal cases in the same period exceeded the filing pace, totaling 4,263 cases. At the end of September 2025, 3,917 criminal cases (excluding RALJ) remained active. Of the 3,917 pending criminal cases, 45% were the MRJC cases.
- <u>Civil Cases</u>. Filings in civil cases (case type 2) continued an upwards trend since the third quarter of 2023. The filings in case type 2 (general civil) in the first three quarters of 2025 were significantly higher than that in the same period in 2024, showing a 17.2% increase from 2024 and totaling 21,610 cases. The increase in civil filings was primarily due to the rise in unlawful detainer cases and civil protection petitions. MRJC accounted for 39% of the civil cases filed in 2025. The overall civil resolutions were lower than the filing volume in the same period, resulting an increase in active civil pending caseload. At the end of September 2025, there were 10,066 civil cases pending disposition, with MRJC having 34% of the pending civil caseload.
- <u>Domestic Cases</u>. Domestic case (case type 3) filings in the first three quarters of 2025 were the same as that in 2024, different by 9 cases only in the same period. A total of 5,056 domestic cases were filed in 2025 so far, and 38% were filed in the MRJC. The resolutions of domestic cases fell slightly behind the filing volume in 2025. At the end of September 2025, the pending domestic caseload was 4,800 cases, with 40% being the MRJC cases. The pending domestic cases is showing an upwards trend in recent quarters.
- <u>ITA Cases</u>. The filings of ITA cases in 2025 remained at a high level, but seemed to have reached a plateau. In the past 5 years, the annual ITA filings were over 5,000 cases. A total of 4,224 ITA cases were filed in the first three quarters of 2025, increasing by 2.6% from the same period of 2024. There were 733 ITA cases remaining to be adjudicated at the end of September 2025, a high volume.
- Juvenile Dependency/Termination (DEP/TER) and At-risk Youth (ARY)/Child-in-Need of Service (CHINS) Cases. In the first three quarters of 2025, termination and truancy filings were lower than that in the same period of 2024. On the other hand, filings in dependency, ARY/CHINS/others were up 12%, and 36% respectively from 2024. At the end of September 2025, the numbers of cases pending disposition in the non-Offense juvenile categories were: 352 dependency cases, 82 termination cases, 242 ARY/CHINS/Other cases, and 1,568 truancy cases.
- <u>Juvenile Offense Cases</u>. The juvenile offense filings in the first three quarters of 2025 showed no noticeable change from the same period of 2024, with a total of 667 juvenile offense cases filed in 2025 so far. The court disposed 706 juvenile offense cases, matching the filing pace in the year. At the end of September 2025, there were 406 pending juvenile offense cases.
- **Pro Tem Use.** In the first three quarters of 2025, the daily Pro Tem use by the court was 3.4, 4.7, and 3.4 FTEs on average, respectively.
- <u>Post-resolution Modifications (Table 1-A)</u>. In the first three quarters of 2025, there were 421 post-resolution modifications filed (both parenting plan and relocation modifications).
- <u>Active re-opened cases and family law modification cases (Table 4-A)</u>. At the end of September 2025, 1,018 re-opened cases and 453 family law modification cases remained active.



Glossary and Definition

Active Status

A case is active if it is not on suspense status (see Suspense Status).

Completion

A case is completed if dispositive document is filed with the court following resolution.

Jury Trial

A hearing is reported as a jury trial if the jury is impaneled.

Non-Jury Trial

A hearing is reported as a non-jury trial if an opening statement is made, waived, or reserved.

Pending Case

A case is defined as pending if it is unresolved and active (not in suspense).

Post-disposition Modifications

Petition to modify parenting plan after the resolution of the original case, based on the modification schedule.

Resolution

A case is resolved if all issues in the complaint are fully adjudicated.

Suspended Case

A case is placed in suspense status from active status during the reporting period.

Suspense Status

A case is on suspense status if it is on warrant, appeal, stay, mediation, arbitration ("Deferred Prosecution" is not a suspense status, but is treated as a resolution).

Trial

A hearing set before a judge or jury in which all the issues in the case are meant to be resolved. A trial normally includes opening statements to the court or jury stating what evidence will show, introduction of witnesses and exhibits for direct and cross examination, final arguments to the court or jury in which counsel argue both the evidence and the law, and judgment by the court or jury stating what the facts of the case are and what law applies to the facts. In a jury case, it also includes the selection of the jury. A trial can be held for one or more cases. A single trial may be held to adjudicate more than one case (as defined above).
