Quarterly Report Summary

King County Superior Court

- **Criminal Cases.** The criminal filings in the first two quarters of 2026 were 2,444 cases, showing a decrease (-8.7%) from the same period in 2025. MRJC accounted for 36% of the criminal cases filed. The resolutions of criminal cases in the first two quarters of 2026 exceeded the filing pace, totaling 2,511 cases. At the end of June 2026, 3,644 criminal cases (excluding RALJ) remained active. Of the 3,644 criminal cases pending, 45% were the MRJC cases.
- **Civil Cases.** Filings in civil cases (case type 2) in the first two quarters of 2026 continued at a high volume at the same level (+0.5%) as in 2025. In the first six months of 2026, the total filings in case type 2 (general civil) were 14,765 cases. The court resolved 13,787 cases in civil category (case type 2), a lower volume than the filing volume in the same period. This has resulted in an increase in pending civil caseload. At the end of June 2026, there were 11,212 civil cases pending disposition, with MRJC having 34% of the pending civil caseload.
- **Domestic Cases.** Domestic case (case type 3) filings in the first two quarters of 2026 were almost identical to that in 2025, different by 3 cases (-0.1%) only. A total of 3,330 domestic cases were filed in the first half of 2026, and 38% were filed in MRJC. The number of resolutions of domestic cases fell slightly behind the filing pace in 2026. The court resolved 3,127 domestic cases in 2026 so far. At the end of June 2026, the pending domestic caseload was 4,832 cases, with 39% being the MRJC cases.
- **ITA Cases.** The filings of ITA cases in 2026 remained at a high level but seemed to have reached a plateau. In the past 6 years, the annual ITA filings were well over 5,000 cases. A total of 2,763 ITA cases were filed in the first two quarters of 2026, just 7 cases (+0.3%) more than in 2025. Year-to-date, the court has resolved 2,884 ITA cases, higher than the filing volume. There were 427 ITA cases remaining to be adjudicated at the end of June 2026.
- **Juvenile Dependency/Termination (DEP/TER) and At-risk Youth (ARY)/Child-in-Need of Service (CHINS) Cases.** Filings in all juvenile related case types showed a decrease in 2026 when compared with 2025. At the end of June 2026, the numbers of cases pending disposition in the non-Offense juvenile categories were: 338 dependency cases, 48 termination cases, 220 ARY/CHINS/Other cases, and 1,990 truancy cases.
- **Juvenile Offense Cases.** The juvenile offense filings in 2026 continued the downward trend when compared with 2025. In the first two quarters of 2026, the court received 304 juvenile offense filings, showing a 32.6% decrease from the same two quarters in 2025. The court resolved 363 juvenile offense cases, exceeding the filing pace in the year. At the end of June 2026, there were 304 juvenile offense cases pending, a low volume.
- **Pro Tem Use.** In the first two quarters of 2026, the court had a Pro Tem use of 3.6 and 4.0 FTEs on average daily, respectively. The majority of the Pro Tem was for commissioner's task and for medical backfill.
- **Post-resolution Modifications (Table 1-A).** In the first two quarters of 2026, there were 265 post-resolution modifications filed (both parenting plan and relocation modifications).
- **Active re-opened cases and family law modification cases (Table 4-A).** At the end of June 2026, 1,065 re-opened cases and 557 family law modification cases remained active.

Total Judicial Cases Only ("Matters Filed with Clerk" excluded)

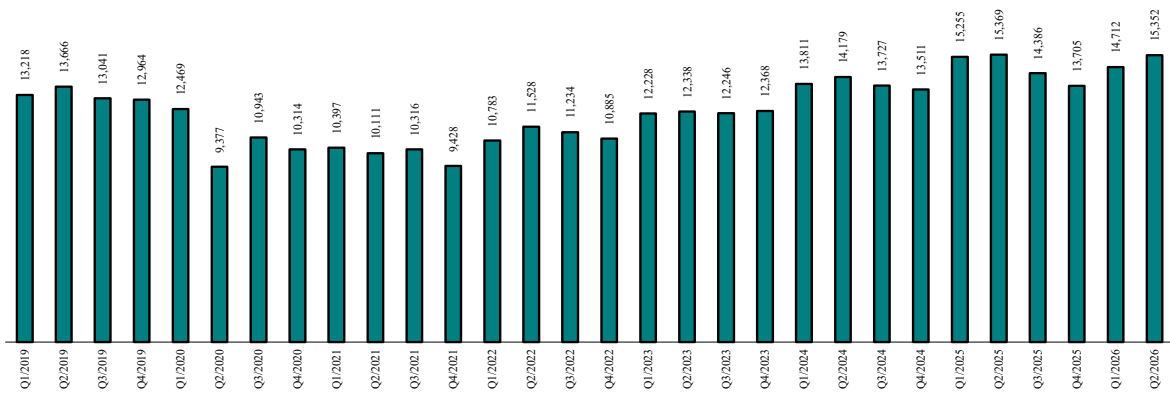


Chart 1-B. Quarterly Filings: Criminal and Juvenile Offense Cases

■ Criminal ■ Juvenile Offenses

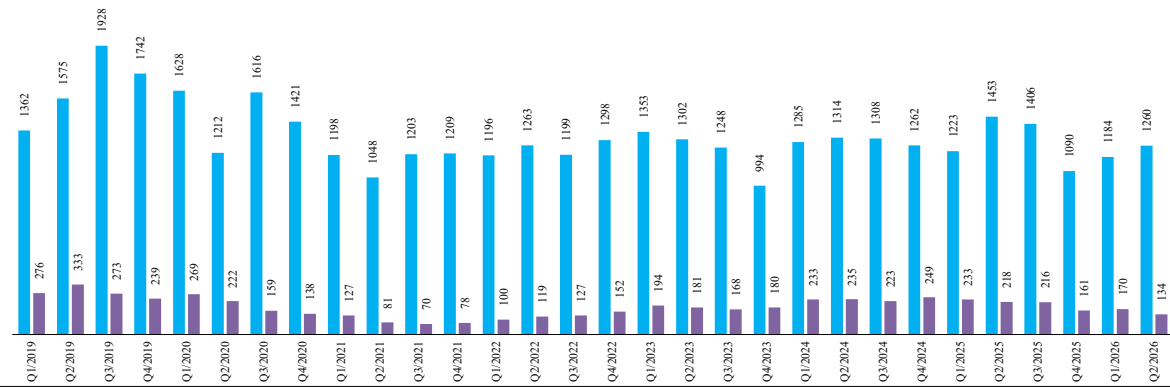
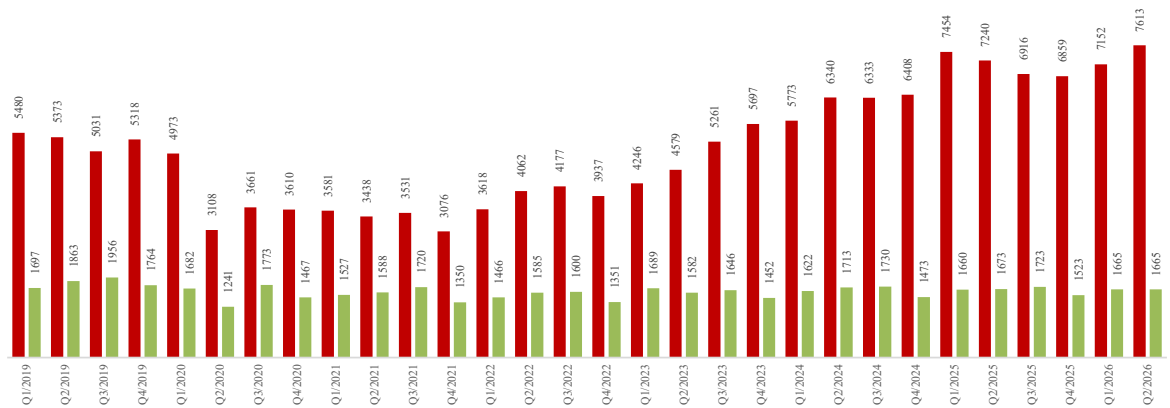


Chart 1-C. Quarterly Filings: Civil and Domestic Cases

Total Judicial Cases Only ("Matters Filed with Clerk" excluded)

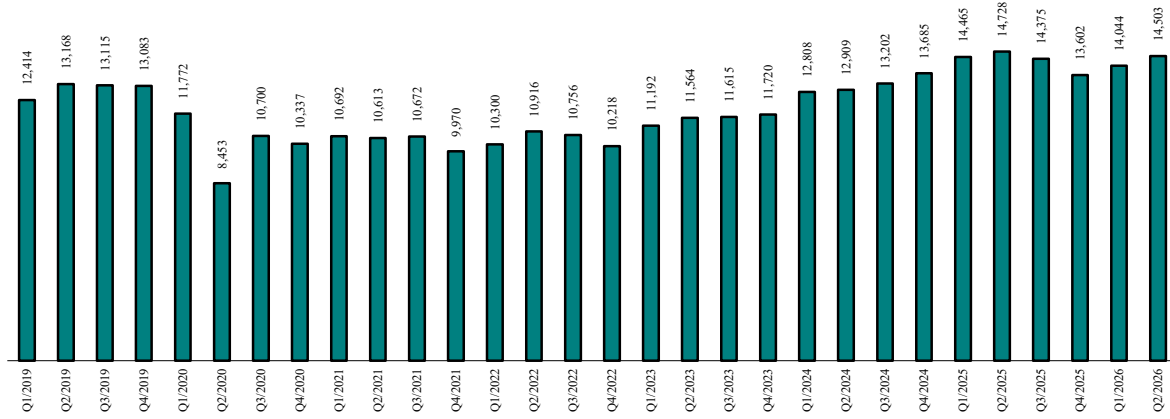


Chart 2-B. Quarterly Resolutions: Criminal and Juvenile Offense Cases

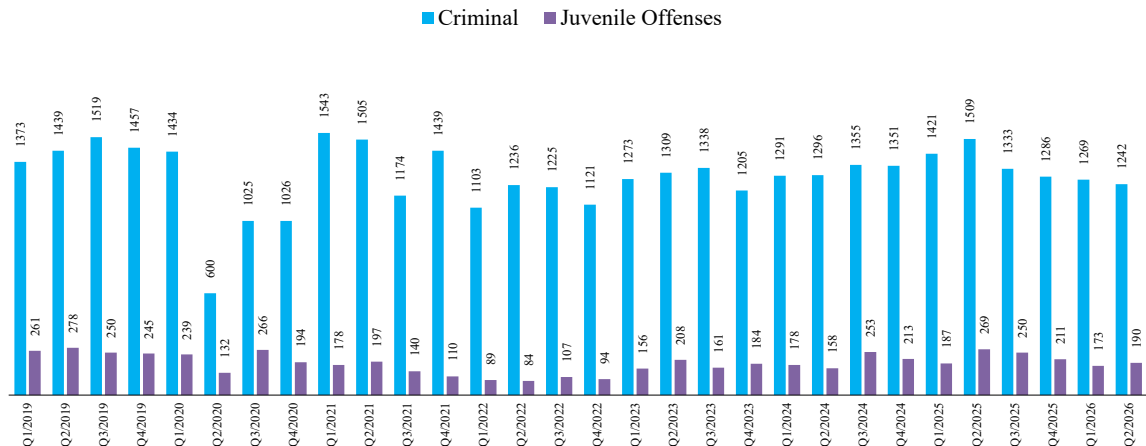
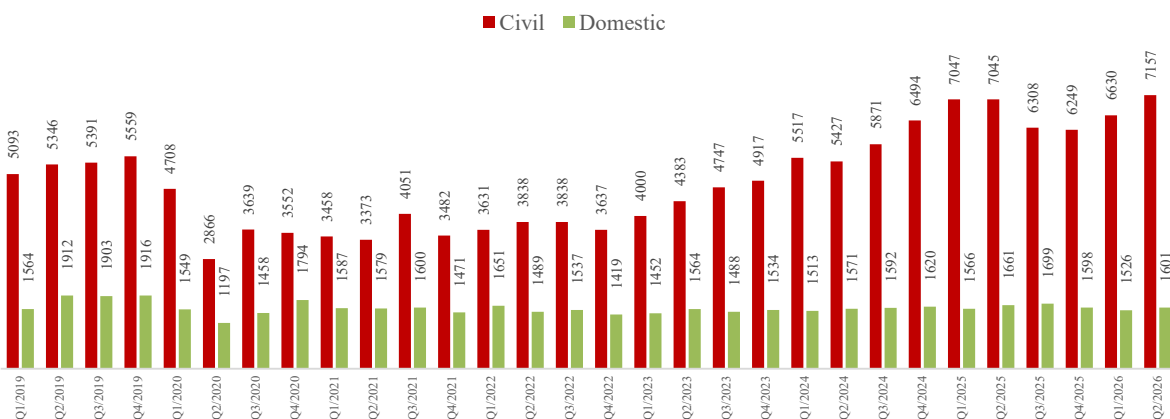


Chart 2-C. Quarterly Resolutions: Civil and Domestic Cases

Total Judicial Cases Only ("Matters Filed with Clerk" excluded)

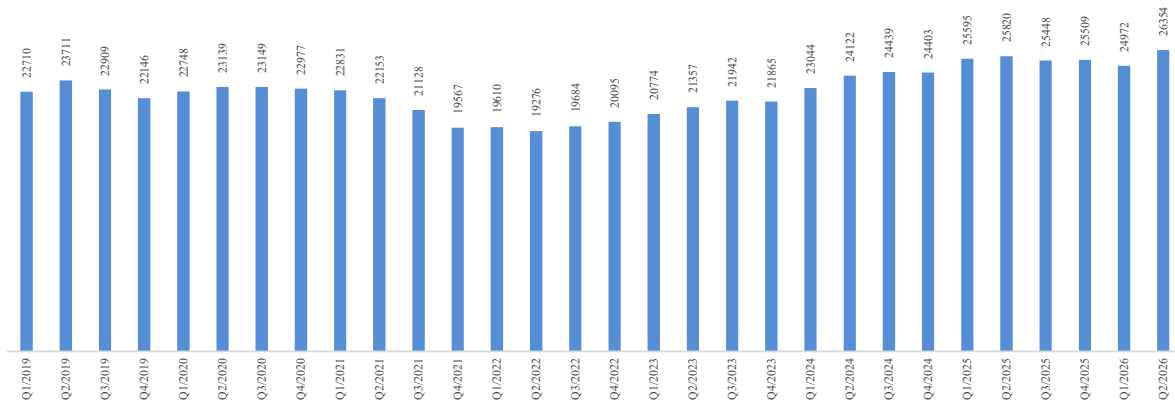


Chart 4-B. Pending Caseload at Quarter End: Criminal, Domestic, and Civil Cases

■ Criminal ■ Civil ■ Domestic

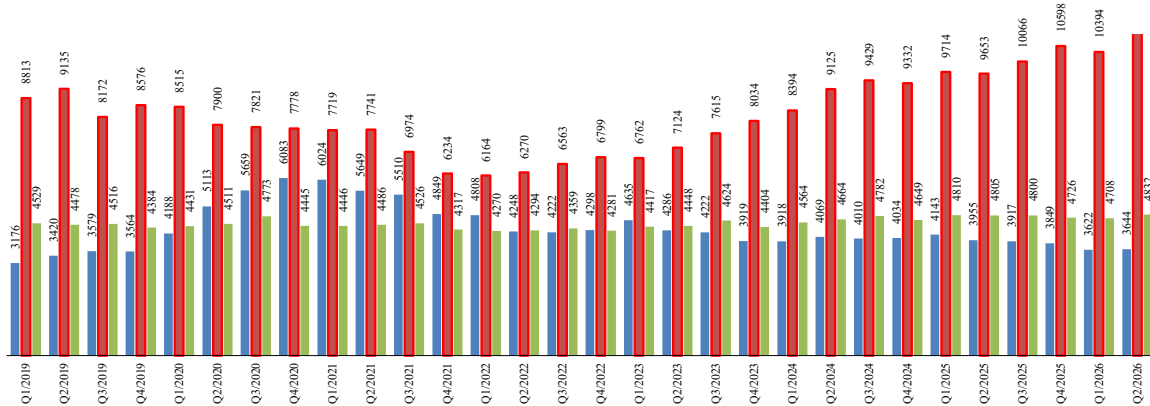
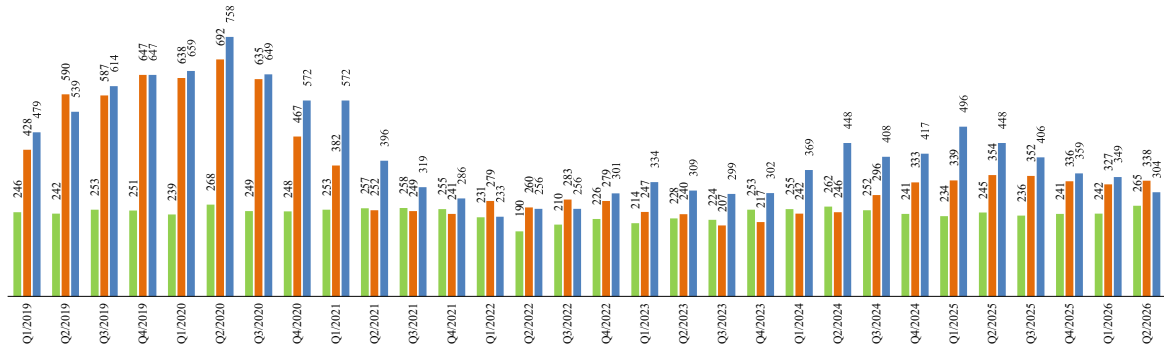


Chart 4-C. Pending Caseload at Quarter End:

Glossary and Definition

Active Status

A case is active if it is not on suspense status (see Suspense Status).

Completion

A case is completed if dispositive document is filed with the court following resolution.

Jury Trial

A hearing is reported as a jury trial if the jury is impaneled.

Non-Jury Trial

A hearing is reported as a non-jury trial if an opening statement is made, waived, or reserved.

Pending Case

A case is defined as pending if it is unresolved and active (not in suspense).

Post-disposition Modifications

Petition to modify parenting plan after the resolution of the original case, based on the modification schedule.

Resolution

A case is resolved if all issues in the complaint are fully adjudicated.

Suspended Case

A case is placed in suspense status from active status during the reporting period.

Suspense Status

A case is on suspense status if it is on warrant, appeal, stay, mediation, arbitration ("Deferred Prosecution" is not a suspense status, but is treated as a resolution).

Trial

A hearing set before a judge or jury in which all the issues in the case are meant to be resolved. A trial normally includes opening statements to the court or jury stating what evidence will show, introduction of witnesses and exhibits for direct and cross examination, final arguments to the court or jury in which counsel argue both the evidence and the law, and judgment by the court or jury stating what the facts of the case are and what law applies to the facts. In a jury case, it also includes the selection of the jury. A trial can be held for one or more cases. A single trial may be held to adjudicate more than one case (as defined above).
