**Phase II: What actions will we take to get there? (2021-2022)**







# Current Activity - Scenario Framing

1. Identify key trends
2. Identify and prioritize uncertainty
3. Create axes of critical uncertainties
4. Combine critical uncertainties
5. Outcome will be multiple topic sentences (frameworks) of a scenario narrative



## Regional Engagement Approach

 <b>External Advisory Group</b>	<b>Advice on Process and Scenario Approach</b>	Quarterly Discussions
 <b>Focused Engagement</b>	<b>Wrestle with tradeoffs, implications, priorities</b>	In-person engagement at key planning milestones with new and interested parties
 <b>Broad Engagement</b>	<b>Informed Light-touch engagement</b>	Online open house, public surveys website, media advertising, engagement with County employees
 <b>Youth Engagement</b>	<b>Strengthen voice in public processes</b>	Workshops, surveys, in-school program events, treatment plant tours
 <b>Tailored Engagement</b>	<b>Tribes, electeds, and regulators</b>	In-person briefings, working sessions
