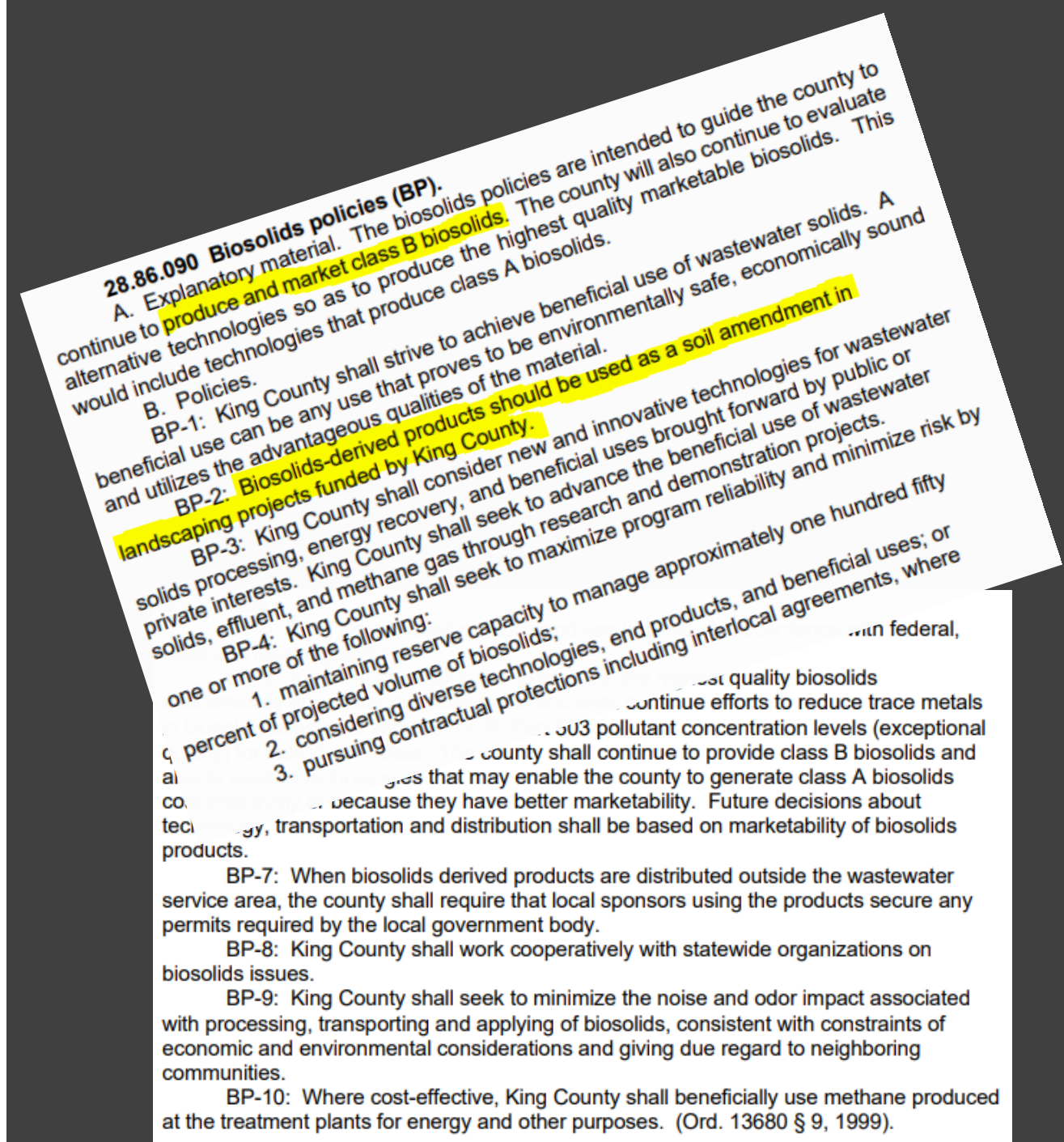

# What would Class A ordinance do?

- Authorize the production and marketing of both Class A and Class B biosolids
  - Code currently limits production to Class B
- Strike the requirement for biosolids compost use in County projects



# Why is this change needed?

- Loop® Class A compost pilot scheduled to be operational by early next year
- Keep up with new technology and industry standards, provides option to diversify products
- Code cleanup to align with recent updates specifying compost use of any feedstock
