

Policies, plans, and documents that meet state requirements for Ecology approval of General Sewer Plan update


Major work components for completing effort

- Obtain ongoing input and feedback from NGOs, tribes, regulators and community
- Early technical code changes
- Later comprehensive update of policies
 - Define a long-term vision for clean water
 - Identify challenges and opportunities
 - Conduct comprehensive planning analysis
 - Develop King County Council planning documents for approval
 - Conduct environmental review (SEPA)
- Submit General Sewer plan amendment to Ecology for approval

Roles and Responsibilities for this effort

- RWQC and King County Council
 - Provide input to vision, policy development, and planning analysis
 - Approve updated policies
- MWPAAC
 - Provide input to vision
 - Provide technical input during planning analysis
 - Provide feedback on draft policy updates
- Executive
 - Recommend vision and policy updates
- WTD
 - Lead effort, coordinate all parties, prepare documentation

Draft Schedule




Early Technical Code Changes – Draft Schedule

- WTD will identify policies that are outdated or incorrect that could be changed without extensive analysis and share the list with RWQC in July
- WTD will share draft edits to MWPAAC in August for review and feedback
- Executive will transfer proposed fixes to KC Council by end of 2024

| October and November | 28.86.090 28.86.100 | Biosolids Water reuse |

^a The timing of the briefing on combined sewer overflow control will depend on the status of the negotiations to modify the CSO consent decree and may be moved up or back as necessary
