Draft Guiding Principles – Together we will...

- Work collaboratively to establish clear and transparent processes, roles, and decisionmaking responsibilities
- 2. Ensure inclusivity in the process
- Listen and respect input, ideas, and feedback from all participants
- 4. Understand the challenges and opportunities facing the regional system
- 5. Develop a shared vision for the future
- 6. Develop policy updates and a plan that aligns with the vision



Draft Guiding Principles – The RWSP Update will...

- 1. Focus on wastewater collection, treatment, disposal, and resource recovery
- 2. Commit to meet regulatory obligations
- 3. Protect and promote equity and social justice
- 4. Balance system needs and affordability
- Protect and improve public health and the environment



Initial Feedback Heard at June RWQC Meeting

- Emphasize "Protect and improve public health and the environment" since it is the mission of the Wastewater Treatment Division
- Consider alternatives to numbering the list (e.g., bullets, visual, etc.), so as not to suggest prioritization
- Provide opportunity to revisit the principles as needed

 July RWQC meeting – Discuss Guiding Principles and receive further input/feedback from RWQC members

 September RWQC meeting – Present revised Guiding Principles and draft resolution for RWQC to consider to adopt the Guiding Principles
