• January 2019 - Completed 90% design

- January 2019 Received Shoreline Substantial Development (SSDP) Permit - South Sammamish B and Inglewood Hill Parking Lot - Phase 1
- November 2019 Received Clearing & Grading Permit -South Sammamish B & Inglewood Hill Parking Lot Ph. 1
- December 2019 Submitted U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Section 404 Permit, awaiting approval

### **Budget:**

• Project Funding. August 2019 - Voters approved the Parks 2020–2025 Parks, Recreation, Trail & Open Space Levy.

- Complete fish culvert designs
- Complete permit approvals

#### Schedule:

- September 30, 2020 Deadline for property owners to complete encroachment removal
- December 2020 Advertise South Sammamish B–Phase 1 construction contract
- Spring 2021 Close trail and begin Phase 1 construction (1.65 miles from SE 33rd Street to Driveway 9 (STA 283+70 to 370+70))
- Advertise South Samm. B-Phase 2 construction contract
- Early 2022 Close trail and begin Phase 2 construction (1.85 miles from Driveway 9 to Inglewood Hill Road (STA 370+70 to 472+81))

### **Pre-Construction Activities:**

- June Nov. 2020- Complete survey updates for design
- May Nov. 2020 Relocate existing utilities as needed
- Nov. 2020 Feb. 2021 Remove major encroachments
