



Upcoming Trail Construction:

Week of 27 September

- STA 290+00 - 291+50: Continue drainage system construction at Waverly Beach
- STA 306+12 - 329+24: Survey for walls 5, 9, 10, and 11.
- STA 329+24 - 375+50: Continue tree felling, and clearing and grubbing.
- STA 329+24 - 375+50: Install high visibility silt fence, following tree removal.
- STA 329+24 - 375+50: Install high visibility fence, following tree removal.
- STA 329+00 - 375+50: Remove Existing Power Hook-Ups
- STA 367+00: Complete Stream #7 drainage system installation.
- STA 306+12 - 352+36: Continue potholing for buried utilities.

Week of 11 October

- STA 290+00 - 291+50: Continue drainage system construction at Waverly Beach.
- STA 299+88 - 305+70: Excavate and grade Walls 3D, 4, and 5.
- STA 299+88 - 305+70: Install Underdrain, Wall Drain, and Rock Pad for Walls 3D, 4 and 5
- STA 314+45: Excavate and grade for Wall 9 and 10.
- STA 329+24 - 375+50: Install high visibility silt fence, following tree removal.
- STA 329+24 - 375+50: Install high visibility fence, following tree removal.
- STA 329+24 - 352+36: Clearing and grubbing.
