## NOTICE OF ACTION TAKEN

**ISSUANCE DATE:** December 9, 2024

**NOTICE IS GIVEN UNDER SEPA, RCW 43.21c.080, THAT THE KING COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND PARKS TOOK THE ACTION DESCRIBED IN (2) BELOW ON DECEMBER 9, 2024.**

- 1. Action Deadline:** Any action to set aside, enjoin, review, or otherwise challenge such action on the grounds of non-compliance with the provisions of chapter 43.21C RCW (State Environmental Policy Act) shall be commenced on or before 4:30 p.m. on January 6, 2025.
- 2. Description of Agency Action:** The King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks made a decision to proceed with the Green River Trail North Extension following this Notice of Action Taken. King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks will obtain the required permits and proceed with this project.
- 3. Description of Proposal:** Construction of approximately 1.4 mile of separated nonmotorized trail, that includes a combination of (1) improving existing trail by widening to standard trail widths, (2) reconfiguring the northbound lane of W Marginal Place S for exclusive use by non-motorized trail traffic, and (3) adding new trail. The project will also make accessibility improvements at signalized intersections and convert the northbound terminus of W Marginal Place S to a roundabout.
- 4. Location of Proposal:** Trail corridor is parallel to the northeast side of West Marginal Place S (SR 99) with southern terminus at Cecil Moses Memorial Park and northern terminus at the city limit of Seattle at S Director Street, in Tukwila and unincorporated King County.
- 5. Type of Environmental Review under the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA):** The King County Department of Natural Resource and Parks is the SEPA lead agency for the proposal and reviewed project information, prepared a SEPA Environmental Checklist, and determined that the project does not have probable significant adverse impacts on the environment, which resulted in issuance of a Determination of Nonsignificance on March 26, 2024 with a 14-day comment period that ended on April 9, 2024. A SEPA environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 43.21C.030(2)(c).


