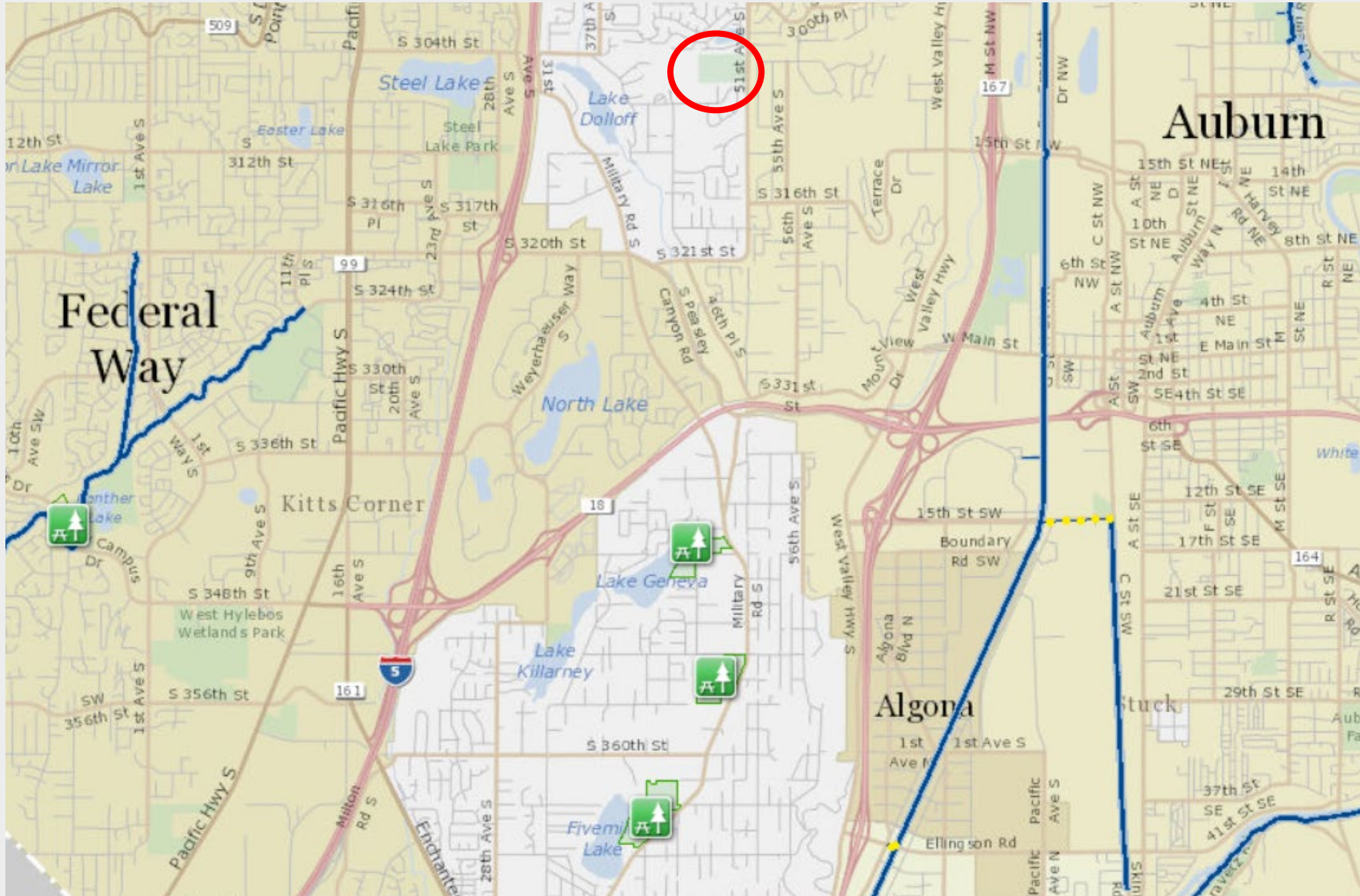
Improving Access to Nature

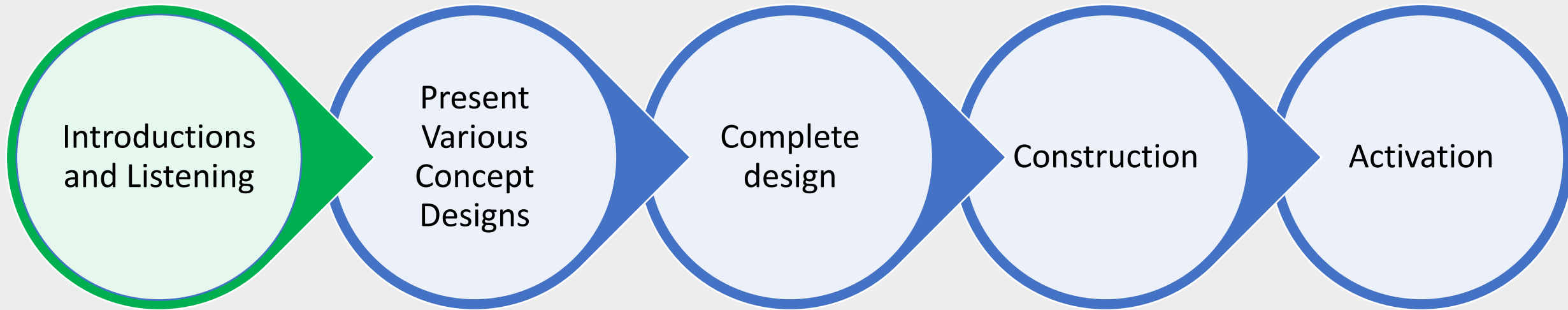
Example Potential Park Design
