NOTICE OF ACTION TAKEN

ISSUANCE DATE: March 27, 2026

NOTICE IS GIVEN UNDER SEPA, RCW 43.21c.080, THAT THE KING COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND PARKS TOOK THE ACTION DESCRIBED IN (2) BELOW ON MARCH 27, 2026.

- 1. Action Deadline:** Any action to set aside, enjoin, review, or otherwise challenge such action on the grounds of non-compliance with the provisions of chapter 43.21C RCW (State Environmental Policy Act) shall be commenced on or before 4:30 p.m. on April 24, 2026.
- 2. Description of Agency Action:** The King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks made a decision to proceed with the Lake Geneva Park Improvements Project following this Notice of Action Taken. King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks will obtain the required permits and proceed with this project.
- 3. Description of Proposal:** King County Parks and Recreation Division is proposing to add a picnic shelter, one basketball court, one tennis court, one pickleball court, and associated amenities to Lake Geneva Park. Three new Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessible parking spaces are also proposed. The existing park's septic system, drainfield and reserved drainfield will be relocated to accommodate the new facilities. The improvements associated with the project will require land disturbance of approximately 1 acre within the 18.5-acre park. The park upgrades will be completed in the upland area, outside of all shoreline zones and wetland/stream buffers.
- 4. Location of Proposal:** Lake Geneva Park, 34429 46th Avenue S, Auburn, WA 98001
- 5. Type of Environmental Review under the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA):** The King County Department of Natural Resource and Parks is the SEPA lead agency for the proposal and reviewed project information, prepared a SEPA Environmental Checklist, and determined that the project does not have probable significant adverse impacts on the environment, which resulted in issuance of a Determination of Nonsignificance on October 22, 2025 with a 14-day comment period that ended on October 29, 2025. A SEPA environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 43.21C.030(2)(c).
