

## **Project Description**

This document addresses comments and questions submitted by the public in fall 2025 during the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) public review and comment period for the Lake Geneva Park Improvements Project. In 2022, this project was proposed by the County's Participatory Budgeting process to provide new sports courts, a community gathering space, and park amenities. The project proposes to add a picnic shelter, one basketball court, one tennis court, one pickleball court, and associated amenities to Lake Geneva Park. Three new Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessible parking spaces are also proposed. The park's existing septic system, drainfield, and reserve drainfield will be relocated to accommodate the new facilities. The improvements associated with the project will require land disturbance of approximately 1 acre within the 18.5-acre park.

## **Questions**

### **1. What is the plan for lighting? Will lights be on after dark?**

On-demand lighting will be provided at the sports courts, picnic shelter and field. That lighting will be available until approximately 10 pm. The exact timing of shutoff of the on-demand lighting has not yet been determined.

### **2. Will native vegetation be used for any proposed landscaping to enhance habitat for fish and wildlife?**

Where landscaping is proposed, native plants will be used.

### **3. Will mature trees be protected?**

The project has been designed to protect all trees near the project site.

**4. Will any critical areas tracts or stream buffers be impacted?**

The project will not impact any wetland or stream buffers.

**5. Will permanent lighting associated with the project be dark shy compliant?**

All proposed lighting will be designed to reduce light pollution and be dark sky compliant.
